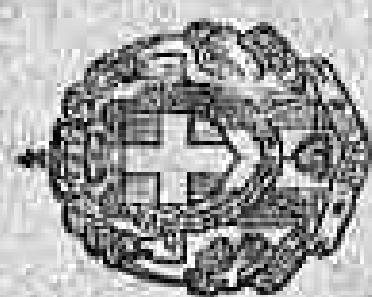

Reference my secret memorandum dated 21st Feb. handed to Col. Jenny para (f).

1) My orders are that Region Lazio Umbria closes finally on 31st March and on that date my office will close - Active operations should have ceased on 16th March.

No instructions have yet been issued as to how fuel for vehicles and Plant on Military Highways will be issued.

In absence of instructions all work in quarries and on military roads will cease for lack of fuel.

In November there were 5 petrolless days owing to instructions for a new system arriving after the old system was stopped, a repetition of such an administrative failure would be unfortunate and perhaps have repercussions on military operations. -

The following suggestions may be helpful to you:

(a) ¹⁵⁰Quantity is about ~~400,000~~ 500,000 Lit. Petrol per month plus Gasoline Oil, ^{60,000} 6,300 hr. Grease.

(b) Factors. In LAZIO work on Military Roads comes under CE3 District Naples (CRE 82 Naples, CRE 104 Rome) and PBS Naples and PBS Leghorn.

Communications and time will make it extremely difficult for Ufficio Speciale Viabilità Statale (Genio Civile) at ROME to contact all these.

(c) Methods.

(i) Genio Civile to present bulk monthly demands on each MILITARY office when approved be responsible for detail issue of Coupons

Reference my secret memorandum dated 21st Feb. handed to Col. Jenny para (f).

- (b) Factors. In LAZIO work on Military Roads comes under CRE3 District Naples (CRE 82 Naples, CRE 104 Rome) and PRS Naples and PRS Leghorn.

Communications and time will make it extremely difficult for Ufficio Speciale Viabilità Statale (Genio Civile) at ROME to contact all these.

(c) Methods.

- (i) Genio Civile to present bulk monthly demands on ~~each~~ ^{MILITARY} office when approved be responsible for detail issue ~~of~~ ^{of} Coupons to contractors - and accounting.
- (ii) Genio Civile apply for Coupons to HQ.A.C.(P.W.) in bulk and be trusted for detail issue and accounting.
- (iii) Italian Government be issued with an additional Bulk issue to cover Military roads on condition that Military Roads receive absolute priority and Genio Civile demand exactly as for Civil Works.
- (iv) A Military office in ROME responsible for issue of Coupons to Contractors on recommendation of Genio Civile and subject to such bulk approvals by Military Engineer officer as they require. -

Recommendation.

Method (iii) is simplest, but priority of Military work might suffer.

Method (iv) would be best.

Method (ii) would ensure them getting petrol but there would be little control.

Method (i) Provides some control but with long distances and bad civil communications would be apt to cause delays. -

During September and October Regional Engineer recommended issues and ADST (Maj Watt) RAC issued releases to Regional Engineer for distribution to Contractors. *at work well*

1. In order to avoid work on Military Roads and also in garages being stopped and with approval of HQ.AG.(PW).-- The quantity of fuel estimated necessary up to 30th April for each contractor with work in progress has been issued between 1st April and 10th April.-- (as per attached list).

2. The need for a decision on future methods of supply subsequent to 1st April was represented by me to Director AG. (PW) on 12th February.-- No decision has been notified and my responsibility is ended.

3. The following is an outline of the present method:-
a) Forecast of needs sent to AFHQ Petroleum Section H.A.G., AG.(PW), Petrol Section AAI by 20th of each month for following month.

This is purely to enable provision to be made for bulk supply. This forecast is based on detail demands from each contractor for each contract.

b) A demand for coupons is made on AG.Hq.(PW) and when received issues are made to contractors 3 times per month.

The quantities actually issued are determined by:-

a) Accounting for previous issues;
b) Tables of maximum and normal use of each type of machine and vehicles.

Most demands are excessive and considerably reduced.

From Aprigliano to COSENZA, the timber will move on the previously mentioned Railway, which will shift the loaded cars to the contractor's saw mill.
- f) Rail transport will be required for moving the lumber from Cosenza to Bastia Station which is near the Bridge site.
- g) Impresa S.A.R.L.I.C. advises that unblocking must be accomplished through 800th American Forestry Unit at Camigliatello, Cosenza Province, which is commanded by Capt. ERIKSON.

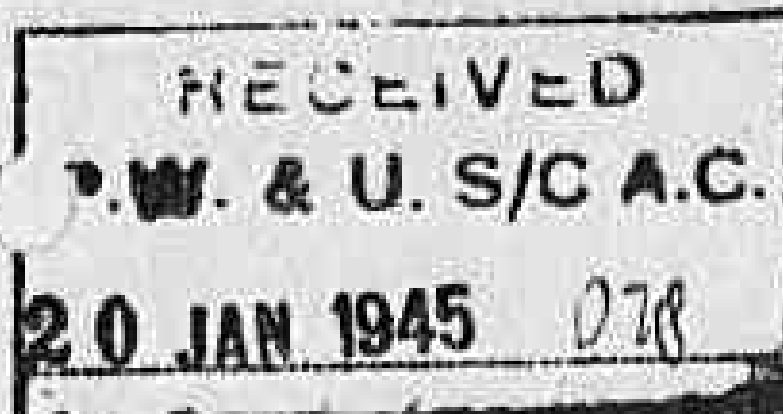

I materiali da noi anticipati come in precedenza chiaramente da noi dichiarato, erano destinati alla fabbricazione dell'emulsione per la manutenzione delle strade della città di Roma interessanti ugualmente le Autorità Alleate, ed attualmente ci occorrono dovendo adempiere agli obblighi contrattuali verso altre Amministrazioni.

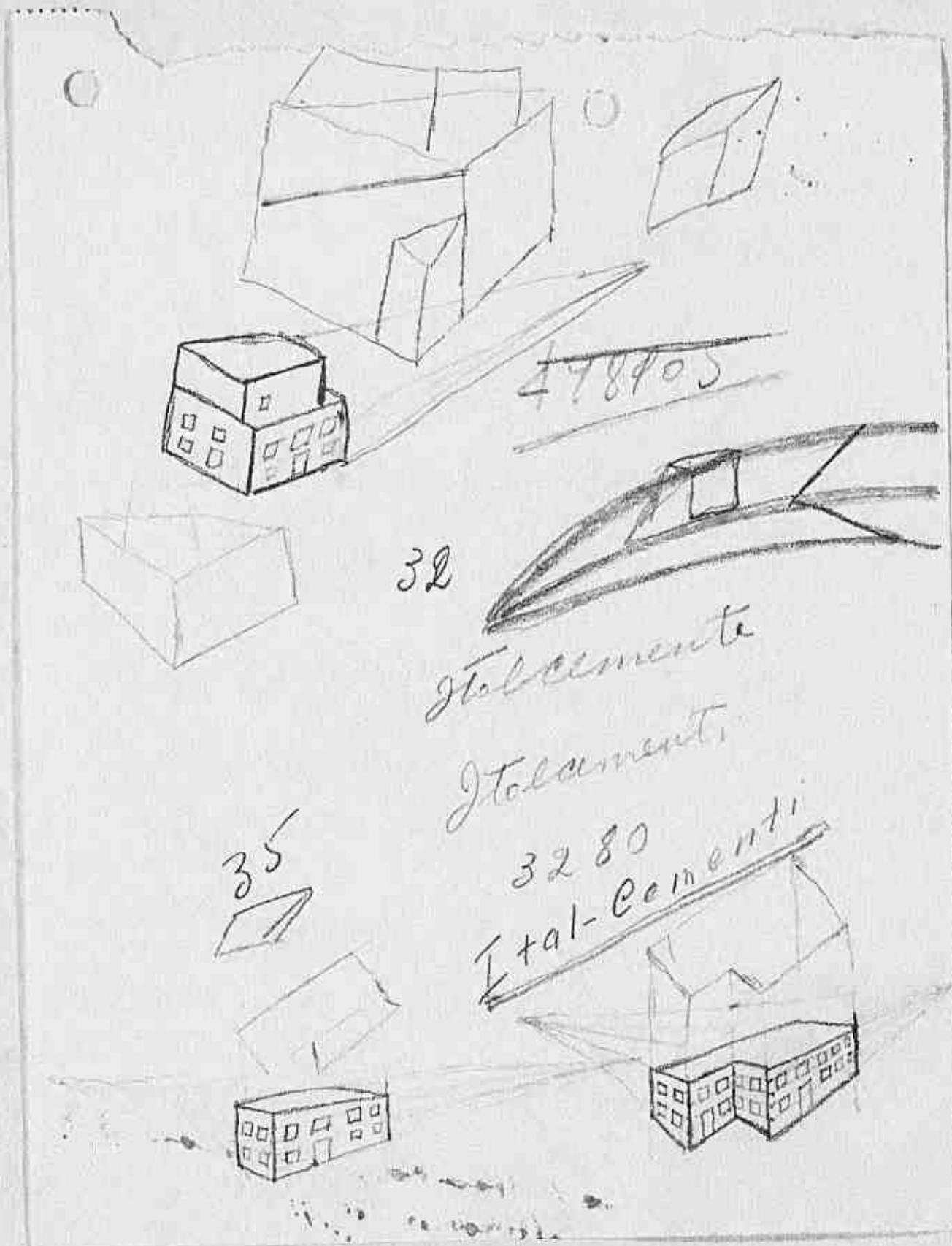
