3. - Ref. RVIII/31/MPAA/11.2 of 27th to P.W. & U, this H.Q.
 This, with the accompanying 76 projects, to a total value of 50,091,643 lire, was received late on July 30th, five days before the two provinces concerned were due to be handed over.
 The projects had been signed by Lt. Hartt between 23 and 28 July. On 31 July, Lt. Hartt was informed by telephone that it would be impossible to check and approve all these projects in the time available, and he was asked to state which were the most urgent.
 A list of 34 buildings, which would be irreparably damaged if not repaired early, totalling 28,521,900 lire, was given. The majority of these were checked and approved.
4. - Considerable delay in checking estimates was caused by the very vague manner in which they were prepared. Very considerable lump sums were shown for certain items, with no details, or dimension, in many cases the unit prices were far too high, and much time was spent ascertaining prices. Errors in simple arithmetic were also conspicuous. Had the projects been prepared with more care, it would have been possible to deal with a larger number.

5. - Attached appendices show projects approved, and those rejected. These include only those projects mentioned in the two letters to which para 1 and 3 refer, as the small number of other Fine Arts projects received during June and July have been approved and do not call for any particular comment.
6. - The position with regard to these two provinces is at least an improvement on that in Toscana Region, when about 200 E.A. projects were received in the last few days before the Region closed. It is hoped that the estimates for repairs to any monuments and buildings of artistic value in the remaining provinces of Liguria Region will be submitted to this office in good time.

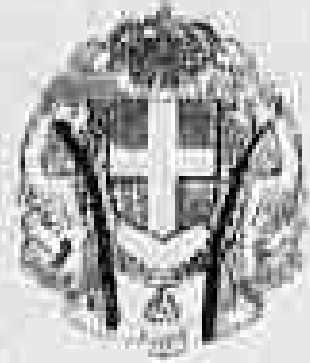

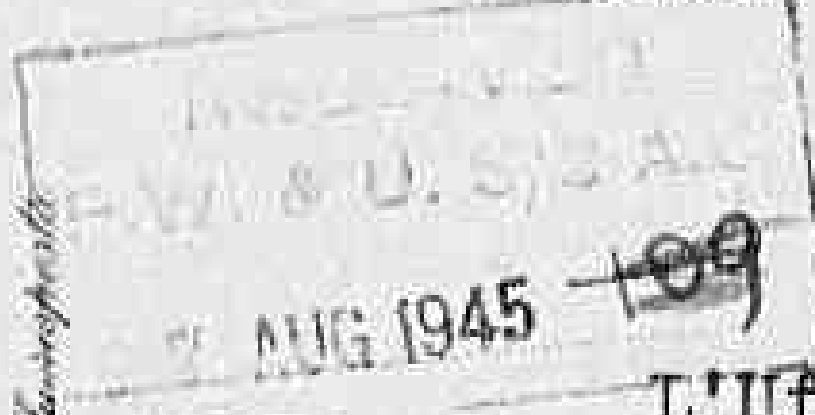

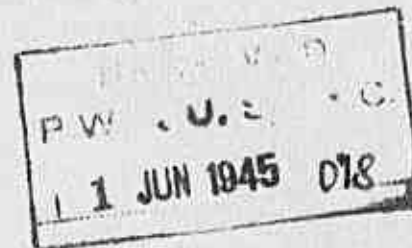
