With reference to letter N° 1984 today's date and the enclosed copies of the letters exchanged with Mr. E. Segre on the matter in question, I wish to add here the following information:

The Chief Engineer of the Genio Civile, Emilio SEGRE, who is 60 years old, was discharged from service, because of the so-called racial fascist laws, while he was at Udine as head of that branch of the Genio Civile.

It results that he passed part of the subsequent period in Genoa and part in Piemonte. Recently in Turin, where he applied to this Inspectorship, asking to be readmitted in service, he expressed the wish to be able to obtain a position in Piemonte, either near Turin or in the city, or else in Genoa. Part of his house furnishings are now stored at Varzi - situated on the highway Voghera-Genoa - and the rest at Pieve Ligure, on the West Riviera.

The papers of this Office - where for several years he occupied the position of Chief Engineer of Genio Civile of Alessandria - show that he was considered an excellent public officer. However, I have no suggestions to make 0 for his settlement here, because all the situations as chief engineer for this Compartimental Inspectorship are

occupied at present. This particular Office also does not feel the need of another functionary of that rank, as there is already one who acts as my collaborator. While I am awaiting superior decisions, I will utilize Mr. Segre's services temporarily as tester of work relating to war damages.


SUBJECT : Clearing Projects

: Public Works & Utilities, Sub-Commission AC

- 1. The city of Turin suffered much damage during the five years of war. Much of the rubble of destroyed structures has been placed in parks and back street, where it is a traffic block, creates an unsanitary situation and hampers the normal life of the city. The engineers of the city were directed to prepare projects for the work of cleaning up this rubble and another for premoving and filling up air raid shelters.
 - 2. These projects are being prepared. The city is divided into zones and estimates are made by zones. Only labor, transport and fuel are required for this work. The cost of clearing the city is estimated by the commune as 25,000,000 lire. This figure has not been checked as yet.
 - 3. In order to put partisans to work it is planned to put this program into effect as soon as the various projects can be set up. Most of the projects are for sums ranging from a few thousand to below a million. Two or three are between 1.000.000 and 2.000.000 and one is roughly estimated to be over 2.000.000.
 - 4. Since no materials are required and work projects are needed to absorb the partisan army and unemployed workers, it is requested that this office be authorized to approve the projects in this special case regardless of cost up to the 25.000.000 total.

SUBJECT : Private Autostrada

TO : Public Works & Utilities Sub-Commission AC

- 1. There are in this area some privately owned autostradas. These are in fair physical condition but the rebuilding of bridges and the maintenance of surfaces is necessary. The financial condition of the owners is not good due to lack of revenue.
- 2. Due to military necessity the work necessary for maintenance and repair will be done by the Genio Civile and any other state roads. At some future time the owners can make arrangements with the Italian Govt. as to exchange of funds, etc.
- 3. If other methods should be used it is requested that this office be advised. It is believed desirable for all such roads in all regions to be handled on the same basis.

Porto) prepared very roughly for the partial reinstatement of dry docks, for your approval. Forms ACC/1 and MAT 10 are submitted in quadruplicate - one copy has been signed by Col. Birchett, the remaining 3 by me.

This project has been prepared for financial reasons after the work was set in motion by O.C.W. Royal Navy who is directing and assisting in the reconstruction of these dry docks and who found there was no other way of paying for the work. It can thus be stated that the R.N. have an interest in getting the docks in order but cannot produce the funds to finance it.

An attempt is being made to arrange a loan temporarily with Intendente di Finance Genoa Province but nothing is definite and if funds are not arranged soon the work will have to stop.

of the Port where Military Engineer units have verbally arranged with specialists such as Electrical - Water - Crane repairers to renew their plant but cannot arrange any payment. It is expected therefore that all these will eventually come up as projects for war damage after the work has been completed. These latter firms however seem to be in 3% better

position to finance their own work and are not having to stop work for lack of funds so far as I know at present.

- It is really necessary now that representatives 4. of the Ministry of Public Works and Ministry of Marine should give some guidance to Consorzio del Porto, (who is the ruling body in this port, a semi government concern) and the Genio Civile here, on the policy which is to be adopted regarding salvage, reconstruction and private enterprise within the port during the next 12 months. Then their engineers and directors can get out some schemes and projects. The present work in hand in the port is solely repairs to existing water, electric power, crane and dry dock installations which are required to meet the 8000 tons a day target forecast for our immediate use and which only cover a fraction of the port facilities. Until some direction is given to Consorzio from above it is difficult for him to decide locally many problems of salvage and repair which are wrapped up in National policy.
- 5. It would be appreciated if this could be brought to the notice of the ruling bodies in Rome.
- 6. The return of the enclosed project authorised by you at an early date would be of assistance.
