La Clinica Dermosifilopatica, funzionante insieme con l'Ospedale S. Lazzaro in Via Cherasco 23, comprendeva i seguenti reparti per ricovero ammalati, e cioè:

- I) - reparto venerici uomini,
- II) - reparto venerice donne (prostitute),
- III) - " cutanei uomini,
- IV) - " cutanee donne,
- V) - " lebbrosi,

ai quali reparti ne vanno ancora aggiunti altri tre, comprendenti:

- reparto venerice donne (oneste)
- " gravide luetiche
- " bambini ereditari
- " bambini blenorragici.

Attualmente dei suddetti 9 reparti, comprendenti oltre 120 letti, non sono funzionanti che un reparto di una ventina di letti per donne venerice (prostitute) ed uno di 5 letti per donne cutanee, provvisoriamente mal sistemati presso l'Opera "Magnificat" a S. Anna di S. Mauro, a circa 8 Km. da Torino. Non è quindi oggi possibile ricoverare alcun malato maschio affetto da malattia venerea o cutanea e neppure esistono reparti per ricovero di bambini blenorragici od ereditari e di donne oneste affette da malattie veneree. Tutte le possibilità di ricovero per malattie cutanee sono ridotte, come si è detto, a soli 5 letti e la necessità di questi reparti è tanto più sentita in quanto la Clinica Dermosifilopatica e l'Ospedale S. Lazzaro sono i soli funzionanti per la specialità dermatovenereologica per le Province di Torino, Aosta, Asti e Cuneo.

In tali condizioni il sottoscritto, Direttore della Clinica, dopo aver già fatto presente la necessità che venga provveduto con sollecitudine alla provvisoria sistemazione della vecchia sede sinistrata alla competente autorità italiana, si permette rivolgere alla S.V. la preghiera di un sollecito intervento affinché il Genio Civile voglia sollecitamente interessarsi perché la Clinica e l'Ospedale possano essere posti in condizione di riprendere la loro attività a Torino.

Data l'urgenza della richiesta, si propone, dopo aver preso visione dei locali sinistrati, che i provvedimenti di sistemazione siano presi in due tempi e cioè:

- in un primo tempo sistemazione provvisoria di 2 padiglioni, realizzabile con relativa poca spesa e scarsità di materiale, nei quali potranno essere alloggiati e provvisoriamente sistemati

1. The city of Turin suffered much damage during the five years of war. Much of the rubble of destroyed structures has been placed in parks and back street, where it is a traffic block, creates an unsanitary situation and hampers the normal life of the city. The engineers of the city were directed to prepare projects for the work of cleaning up this rubble and another for removing and filling up air raid shelters.

2. These projects are being prepared. The city is divided into zones and estimates are made by zones. Only labor, transport and fuel are required for this work. The cost of clearing the city is estimated by the commune as 25,000,000 lire. This figure has not been checked as yet.

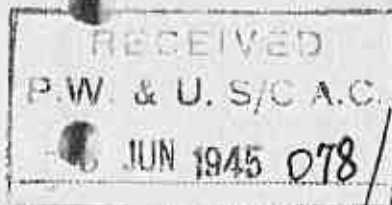
3. In order to put partisans to work it is planned to put this program into effect as soon as the various projects can be set up. Most of the projects are for sums ranging from a few thousand to below a million. Two or three are between 1.000.000 and 2.000.000 and one is roughly estimated to be over 2.000.000.

4. Since no materials are required and work projects are needed to absorb the partisan army and unemployed workers, it is requested that this office be authorized to approve the projects in this special case regardless of cost up to the 25.000.000 total.

1. Enclosed please find Project n° 1 (Consorzio del Porto) prepared very roughly for the partial reinstatement of dry docks, for your approval. Forms ACC/1 and MAT 10 are submitted in quadruplicate - one copy has been signed by Col. Birchett, the remaining 3 by me.

2. This project has been prepared for financial reasons after the work was set in motion by O.C.W. Royal Navy who is directing and assisting in the reconstruction of these dry docks and who found there was no other way of paying for the work. It can thus be stated that the R.N. have an interest in getting the docks in order but cannot produce the funds to finance it.

An attempt is being made to arrange a loan temporarily with Intendente di Finance Genoa Province but nothing is definite and if funds are not arranged soon the work will have to stop.

3. This situation has arisen in several other sections of the Port where Military Engineer units have verbally arranged with specialists such as Electrical - Water - Crane repairers to renew their plant but cannot arrange any payment. It is expected therefore that all these will eventually come up as projects for war damage after the work has been completed. These latter firms however seem to be in a better

position to finance their own work and are not having to stop work for lack of funds so far as I know at present.

4. It is really necessary now that representatives of the Ministry of Public Works and Ministry of Marine should give some guidance to Consorzio del Porto, (who is the ruling body in this port, a semi government concern) and the Genio Civile here, on the policy which is to be adopted regarding salvage, reconstruction and private enterprise within the port during the next 12 months. Then their engineers and directors can get out some schemes and projects. The present work in hand in the port is solely repairs to existing water, electric power, crane and dry dock installations which are required to meet the 8000 tons a day target forecast for our immediate use and which only cover a fraction of the port facilities. Until some direction is given to Consorzio from above it is difficult for him to decide locally many problems of salvage and repair which are wrapped up in National policy.

5. It would be appreciated if this could be brought to the notice of the ruling bodies in Rome.

6. The return of the enclosed project authorised by you at an early date would be of assistance.
