Subject: POL Coupons - Military Contractors.

To : Regional Commissioner, Piemonte.
 (Att: Regional Engineer).

1. The supply of coupons for Contractors employed on works of military significance has today again been discussed with Commerce Sub-Commission.

2. It is their desire that the special military coupons be withheld from Northern Regions for the present, as:

- (a). Their representative Major Brereton, is now in the north with reference to POL supplies and availability.
- (b). Total supplies now available will not permit issuance of additional coupons.

3. Pending final settlement of this matter, it is suggested by Commerce that ordinary coupons be obtained from Regional Commerce Officer and used for military works up to the amount of POL available. Ordinary coupons used for this purpose must be stamped by you in some satisfactory manner so as to be clearly identified as applicable to military works.

4. It is hoped this entire situation will be clarified upon the return of the Commerce representative from the north.

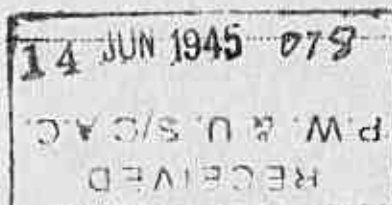

SUBJECT: Method of obtaining Materials from
Military Sources

TO : Public Works & Utilities, Sub-Commission AC ✓

1. In the ports in the Ligurian Area a situation has arisen which requires special consideration. The situation is as follows.

- a. The military (RN., AN., US. Army, British Sub Area and other units) have all stocks of materials and supplies.
- b. These will not be released to civilians.
- c. These supplies call for cash payment.
- d. Payment from civilians not allowed.

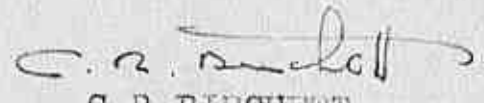
2. The situation is critical since many military engineer units are involved and there is available for reconstruction in the port area a large organized group ready with skilled personnel and equipment. Provided a few supplies can be made available work can commence immediately.

3. Therefore it is suggested that authority be obtained so that materials can be drawn from military sources by AMG, payment made by AMG and their materials turned over at cost to the civil contracting firms. This would involve no change in funds only a bookkeeping record which could be handled by the PW&U Sect 3826 as in Rome. It is requested that immediate steps be taken to obtain this authority or to arrive at some plan whereby materials can be transferred to civilians from military stocks.

4. It is requested that this office be advised of actions taken. If approval is obtained for actions indicated in paragraph 3 it is requested that 10 CRE be advised.

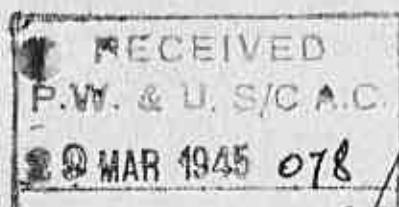

SUBJECT: POL for Military Projects

TO : Regional Commerce Officer (Lt.Col. Reiter)

1. Reference is made to your letter PR/CO/13/B dated 24 March 1945 subject POL Ration Forms.

2. This office will look to the FW&U Sub-Commission for its supply of ration coupon books for issuing to contractors engaged in work on military projects. It is understood that the CIP dispensing stations in all parts of the Region will know these coupons and that there will be available sufficient quantities of gasoline, oil and lubricants to meet whatever quantity of coupons may be allotted by the FW&U Sub-Commission. Responsibility for supplying CIP with the necessary POL to meet initial military project demands and, subsequently, for redeeming military project coupons presented, will not be a function of the Regional Engineers' office.

Subject : POL - Ration Notes.

To : Regional Engineer.

1. Reference Par. 3, memo. PR/CO/43/B dated 12 March 1945 (initiated on memo).

2. Conversation with Capt. Conlin, Commerce S/C and Capt. Engleard, Public Works and Utilities S/C., HQ. AC., confirmed the procedure set forth in POL Instruction No. 2, ACC/5145/Com. dated 10 August 1944, subject "POL Supplies for Contractors Employed on Military Projects", in that

- a. The Public Works and Utility Sub-Commission will supply Regional Engineers with the special POL coupon books for contractors on military projects.
- b. These special coupons are to be issued by the Regional Engineers for purchase of POL for military contracts only from OIF, who replace this POL from Army Supplies. POL allocated for civilian uses by Pet. Ac., AFHQ will not be used for military operations, as all civilian POL must be paid for and the 35 centesimal fee collected for each liter and/or kilogram thereof. Military POL is exempted from these payments.
3. Since these special coupons and POL for military contracts will not be handled by Commerce Officers, it is recommended that the Regional Engineer take the matter of procurement of these items directly through the Public Works and Utilities Sub-Commission, HQ. AC.

4. Memo. AC/Com/POL/25 dated 26 Oct. 1944, was requested by your office. Capt. Conlin informed me that copy thereof was handed to your Italian officer representative and should be in your hands now.

2. Conversation with Capt. Cowlin, Comares S/C and Capt. Shepherd, Public Works and Utilities S/C., HQ. AC., confirmed the procedure set forth in POL Instruction No. 2, AC/5146/Com. dated 10 August 1944, subject "POL Supplies for Contractors Employed on Military Projects", in that

- a. The Public Works and Utility Sub-Commission will supply Regional Engineers with the special POL coupon books for contractors on military projects.
 - b. These special coupons are to be issued by the Regional Engineers for purchase of POL for military contracts only from CIP, who replaces this POL from Army Supplies. POL allocated for civilian uses by Pet. Sec., AFHQ will not be used for military operations, as all civilian POL must be paid for and the 55 centennial fee collected for each liter and/or kilogram thereof. Military POL is exempted from these payments.
3. Since these special coupons and POL for military contracts will not be handled by Comares Officers, it is recommended that the Regional Engineer take the matter of procurement of these items directly through the Public Works and Utilities Sub-Commission, HQ. AC.
