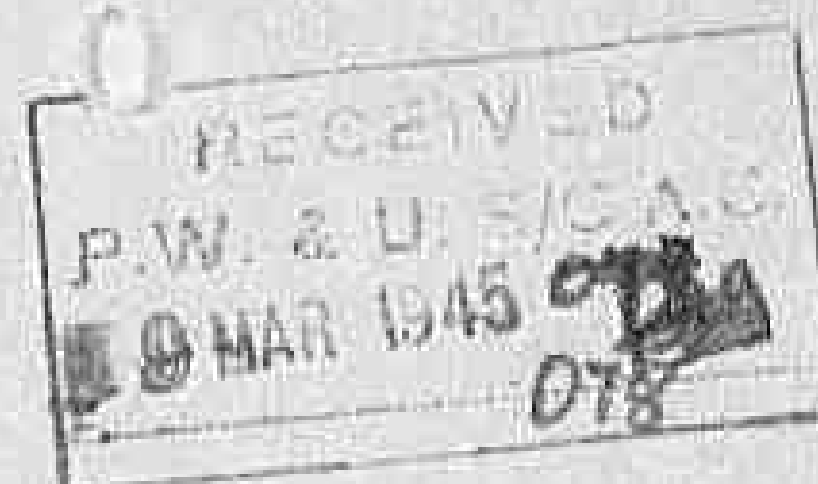

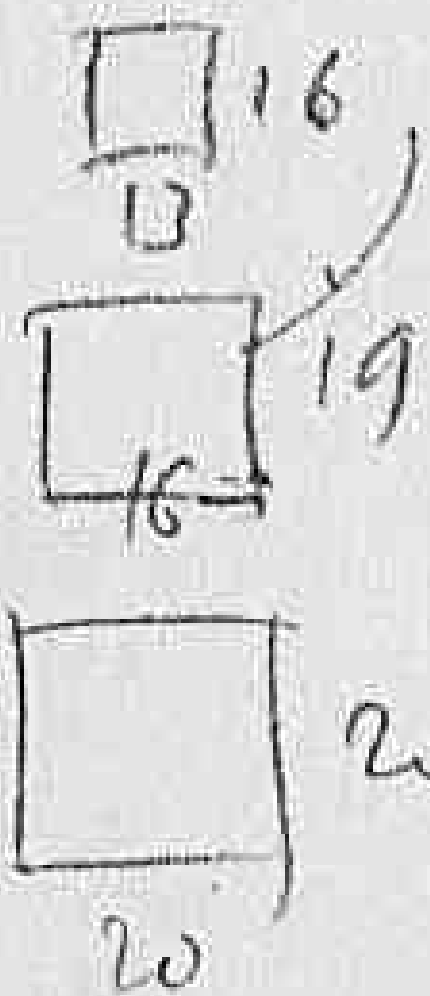

1. The enclosed message was delivered to the Regional Engineer, Abruzzi-Marche Region V on 28 December 1944.

2. Capt. Sheppard (Public Works and Utilities Sub-Commission) was contacted by telephone and asked to do what was necessary to relieve the situation.

3. It is requested that strong representation be made to the proper Officers, based on two points, viz - 1st. Transportation Sub-Commission (Railways) came into Abruzzi-Marche Region to do considerable engineering work calling for the use of a great deal of labor and construction material without the courtesy of notifying either myself or the Regional Engineer as to their intention, not to mention inquiring as to available materials. 2nd. They have now, either by requisition or the payment of exorbitant prices, drawn from the market construction material necessary for the building of bridges on Military Highways. This is not the first instance in which contractors on railway reconstruction have disrupted the labor and materials market by over bidding Army and Public Works allowable prices.

4. The present tying up of available brick supply is most serious, stopping as it does the work on eight to ten Military Roads of high priority and great urgency. One of these is the rebuilding of temporary piers and abutments over the Pescara River at Pescara City to release a Bailey Bridge for Route 16, our main East coast Military road. This work must be completed before 15 January 1944 in order to release the low level Bailey bridge further up the river which may

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5. This is a matter of great urgency and I request that it be taken up immediately to the end that 300,000.- brick be released at once.
6. The Regional Engineer will be prepared to discuss this further at the conference called for 8 January.

1. There are six steel girders 60 cm. by 16 Meters and three hundred steel points in the Railway Yards at Roseto Degli Abruzzi. This material apparently was in transit when damaged by explosives and ownership is undetermined.

2. There also are damaged girders near the railroad bridge in the river bed of the Tordino River from which length of about five meters may be salvaged.

3. These girders are urgently needed for bridge construction on Military Highways in this Region.

4. It is requested authority be granted this Office for the removal and use of the materials indicated.

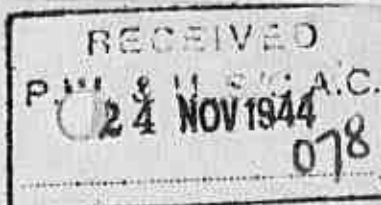

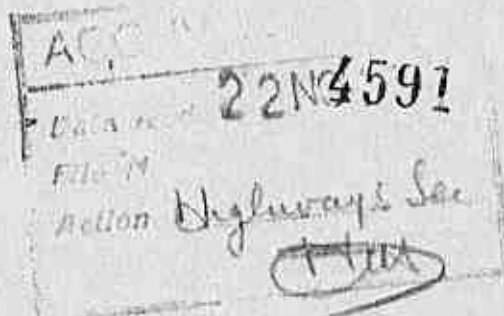

Reference conversation Lt. Col. V.S. THOMPSON and  
Major Fogan on 13 Nov. 44 and 14 Nov. 1944.

1. Contractor Laudisa holds contracts with the  
Genio Civile and at the direction of this Sub-Commission, for  
the reconstruction of bridges on Route 82 in Abruzzi-Marche  
Region South of Avezzano. This work, which is well underway, has  
now been halted due to the fact that civil P.O.L. supplies avail-  
able to the Region are inadequate.

2. Shortly after the occupation of the Province of  
Aquila, Route 82 was given urgent, Civil priority by higher Au-  
thorities as it was the most direct route between the food pro-  
ducing Area near Avezzano and Naples. To date many millions of  
lire have been expended on the bridges on this road and even  
though its importance as a supply route has decreased, work now  
in progress must be carried to completion so that effort and  
expenditure to date shall not be sacrificed.

3. We wish to request that a special allocation of  
P.O.L. for the completion of this work be made to Abruzzi-Marche  
Region. Estimated requirements are as follows.

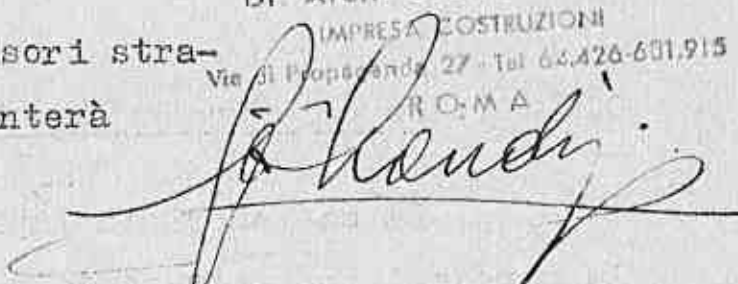
