: Public Works Sub-Commission. To

- 1. San Benedetto del Tronto before the war was one of the most important fishing centers in Italy. This not only because of its proximity to very rich fishing grounds in the Adriatic but also because of its development in mo= tor and sail boats and equipment.
- 2. In its retreat the enemy left in its wake heavy damages to the port itself and to the nearby market.
- 3. At present it is difficult for motor fishing schooners to take refuge in the port because the breakwater wall was mined at several points. As result the fishing boats have mo= ved south.
- 4. It has been estimated that it would take from seven to ten million lire to repair the damages at the sea wall and at the market. The Genio Civile of the locality has been requested by fishing interests of San Benedetto to give an accurate estimate.

5. This Sub-Commission strongly recommends that the re= pairs be effected and it desires to know what procedure to take to get the project approved once the final estimate of cost is completed.
