



SUBJECT : Carbon Bisulphide Production

TO : ✓ Public Works & Utilities Sub-Commission

R. J. T.

1. This Sub-Commission is actively concerned with the rehabilitation of the Carbon Bisulphide plant of Ulisse Crocchi at Torrenieri (Siena).
2. Transportation of raw sulphur from the mine of Cabernardi, via Fabriano, is essential. The road between Cabernardi and the railhead at Fabriano is in poor condition owing to demolitions and is further deteriorating under present weather conditions. It will shortly become entirely impassable for the heavy lorries carrying the sulphur, and the production of Carbon Bisulphide essential for grain protection and the refining of edible olive-oil will cease.
3. It is requested that you take whatever action is proper (presumably in liaison with Garrison Engineer of the area concerned) to have this road maintained during the winter months.

SUBJECT: Sulphur - Italian Mainland and Perticara.

TO : Chief, Mining Division, Industry Sub-Commission.

1. The writer attempted a trip to the Carbernardi mine, Ancona Province, and the Perticara mine, Pesaro Province on 9, 10 and 11 October, but was unable to reach these mines because of impassible roads. The situation is as follows:

- a. Bailey Bridges in the area north of Fabriano on route 76 (Railroad point of Carbernardi), south of Fossonbrone on route No. 3 and west of Senigallia on route No. 16 (See sheet 14, 1:200,000 Road Map of Italy) have been removed by the 8th Army.
- b. By-passes are reported to be provided around the bridge sites, but in wet weather most of these are impassible to any motor transport because of both mud and high water in the streams.
- c. As a result the stock of sulphur at Garbernardi cannot be moved, or supplies brought in for operations until bridges are provided. The writer was informed at Fabriano that wet weather usually continues throughout the winter in this area.
- d. There are about 14 bridges out on the road between Fabriano and Carbernardi, via Sassofermo ~~4804~~.
- e. There are about 10 bridges out via an alternate route from Valtreara on route 16 through Sasso-ferrato to Carbernardi.

- f. The Provincial Commissioner, Ancona Province intenedes to push bridge reconstruction on route, see par. e., and promised to forward an estimate of the cement required for construction of permanent bridges to Mining Division, HQ. ACC.
 - g. Availability of timber for temporary bridges is not known.
2. The Provincial Commissioner, Ancona Province states that electric power (500 KW) for Carbernardi will not be available for several months, minimum.
3. The writer was informed by AMG at Pesaro that the condition of the roads to the Perticara Mine is the same at the Carbernardi.

The writer on coming into the area submitted representation to H.Q., P.W. & U. Sub Commission, that another Contractor be employed on the above road.

These representations were made on the following grounds:-

- (a) Commitment of S.I.C.S.L.P. would not permit of sufficient progress being made to complete this summer.
- (b) The extremely bad & dangerous condition of the road, which had almost reached the stage of being impassable.
- (c) No other contractors with sufficient plant & material available within the area, at the time.

Impresa Ing. CIAPPARELLI was nominated by H.Q., P.W. & U. Sub Commission & instructed to commence work on 3rd July, at ARIANO. Impresa S.I.C.S.L.P. working from the BOVINO end of the road.

A schedule of prices was subsequently submitted, which were greatly in excess of those under which S.I.C.S.L.P. was carrying out the work, & also of the AA&S engineers estimate. Sec. APP "A".

A discussion took place, & Impresa CIAPPARELLI, maintained that his prices were reasonable, relying mainly on the fact that he was being paid approximately the same prices for similar work in the NAPLES area.

In view of the wide disparity in prices & the instructions of 14 CE. Works N° 2 Dis. letter ref CE/IOI of 3 May 44, the Contractor was informed that the prices were not acceptable, & should be reconsidered. He was also instructed to submit a detailed analysis of his prices.

There was no response to this instruction, & a final conference was called for 8 Aug. 44., at which were present:-

Ing. D'Avanzo - on behalf of Impresa CIAPPARELLI intimated that he was not prepared to alter his prices, an analysis was not submitted. He still maintained that he could get these prices in the NAPLES District.

He was informed that the prices were absurdly high & could not be considered. Orders were then given for work to cease on the following day, & plant removed.

Ing. D'Avanzo thereupon produced an account for the work carried out to date. It was evident the firm was prepared for removal from the work, & had no intention of trying to cooperate.

This account was on a similar basis, of unreasonable prices. Ing. Foglia was instructed to consider the account & submit his valuation of the work. (See Appendix "B"). Impress CIAPPARELLI to be paid the amount of Ing. Foglia's valuation, the difference to be subject to settlement by arbitration or similar method.

Comments on the prices as shown in APP A & B, are unnecessary. The prices of Ing. Foglia & Impress S.I.C.B.L.P. being an average of those ruling in the District.

Arising from these observations it would appear that.

- (a) The prices of CIAPPARELLI are extortionate, especially the account submitted, for work carried out.
- (b) There was no intention to cooperate in this matter.
- (c) The prices, which CIAPPARELLI contend they are being paid in the NAPLES area, require some investigation.
- (d) This firm should not be allowed to execute any further works under ACC supervision & the facts brought to the notice of the Ministry of Public Works.

Subject: Road Maintenance ; Vasto - Sangro Road.

To : Chief Engineer, 2 District.

Reference your 1402/101/5/3 dated 28 August 1944

1. We concur entirely in your opinion that the reduction in Cantonieri forces on the Vasto-Sangro Road is a serious matter.

2. Immediately upon receipt of your advice the Regional Engineer, Region V, was instructed to make a thorough investigation of this situation and to take whatever immediate action was necessary to ensure the employment of adequate workmen.

3. This matter has also been discussed with the Ministry of Public Works so that general corrective instructions may be given to local Civil Authorities.

1. 21 CE Works at VASTO inform this office that MASS acting on instructions from Engineer Troilo of Genio Civile at CHIETI has reduced all road labour in his district to practically nil, despite protests by 21 CE. He gives, as the reason for this, lack of funds to pay his men.

2. The gravel surface of the roads affected viz road VASTO - CASALBORDINO - SANGRO R and VASTO - CASALBORDINO - STA - TORINO DI SANGRO STA - SANGRO R, is in bad condition and deteriorating rapidly.

3. This is a serious matter both in principle and infact. Will you please investigate and instruct the civil authorities to proceed with the road maintenance work to the required extent forthwith. It is not understood in this office how the plea of lack of funds can have any foundation whatever at this stage.
