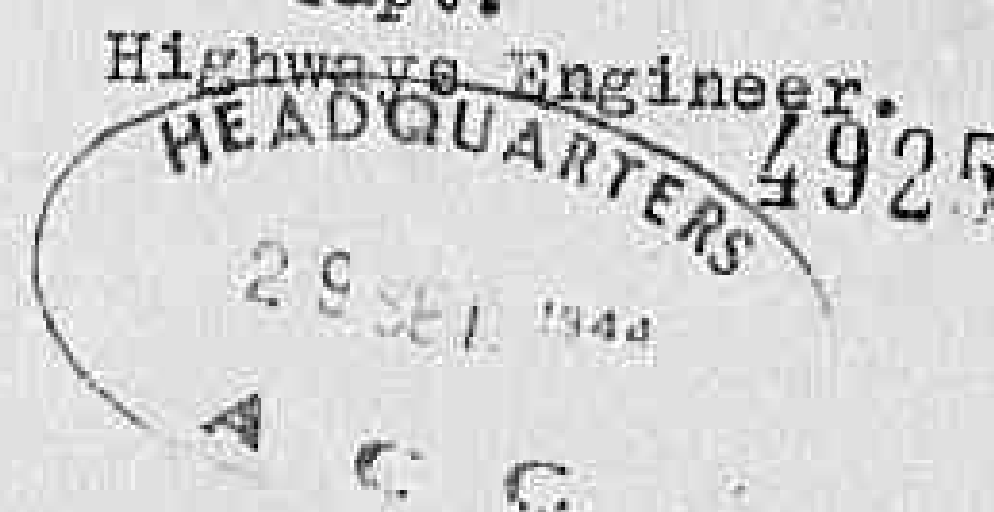

How your Inspectorship has relieved, they are, in fact, the instructions n. 3, orders given from the Subcommission for Public Works of the Allied Commission of Control, in one to those n. 4, also dated 8/6/last June n. 24293 - safe some more duplication, in consequence to the new division and organization of the Regions, like to those communicated in the past time with letter 8 March 1944 n. 2268.

Reference the two projects you asked me to look into at Potenza. I told my public works Engineer to investigate the reports as follows

No. 1. Repair to Bldg. used as
Barracks for 67 Corps Firemen

He states there was a first estimate for L.100.000 which was financed by Intendenza di Finanza, for repairs caused by bombs, this work has been executed.

The amount of the estimate now submitted to you he states is for L. 75.000 and ^{not} L.1,000.000 as given on your note to me. This is for repairs to the flat roof which is in bad shape being badly cracked. The rooms below being unusable when it rains. There being a hole 50 sq. meters caused by bomb explosion. The entire roof surface is about 500 sq.m. He states no essential materials needed. This can be approved.

No. 2. Repairs to Post office & Telephone building

Mancenelli reports the work is essential and was caused by bombs. The amount being reasonable, and no vital materials involved.

Reference this office letter PW&U/LO/4 dated 16 April 1944 forwarding estimates for the Bari = Ganosa Road and Bari = R. Ofanto Road which you approved.

This estimates were based on the contractor providing the chippings, since then, it has been decided that a separate contract be made for chippings, as contractors who are able to undertake the work cannot provide the chippings.
