1. We note from Major Chamberlain's last monthly Report, that certain road projects under his supervision are being seriously delayed due lack of transport.

2. It has occurred to us that it might be possible to partially relieve this situation by the temporary transfer of two or three of the W.D. vehicles from the Northern Section of your Region to this Area.

3. Will you please consider the advisability of this suggestion, bearing in mind, of course, the relative seriousness of your transport problems in both the Areas concerned and the possibility of others of these trucks being required on the upper part of Route 6, outside your Region. This latter possibility has been discussed with C.E., 3 District who will take the matter up with you.

Subject: Garage facilities for Genio Civile.

To : Lt-Col. V.S. Thompson.

On 7th June, accompanied by Sig. Basso, Engineer Genio Civile, I inspected the proposed parking and Garage facilities for Genio Civile vehicles and report as follows:

VEHICLE PARKLocation - Via Poggioreale.Accommodation - 60-70 Vehicles, no cover.

Facilities - Open parking. Three lock-up stores in one storey building 65'0" x 16'0". Use for spare parts, tools, etc., and carrying out minor repairs. Open fronted shed to be erected. 40'0" x 20'0" as repair bay.

Security - Bounded two sides by streets wall 11'0" high. Two sides abut Municipio stores yard - 10'0" walls. Night and day watch man.

Remarks - Previously part of Municipio works store yard. Being requisitioned by Genio Civile. Good as vehicle park.

GARAGES

1. Location - Vaults under National Museum H.Q. Genio Civile Via Foria.

Accommodation - 10 Cars.

Facilities - Inspection pit. Bench for minor repairs. Storage space in inner vaults for spare tools, stores, etc.

Security - Lock up outer gates to grounds. Lock up garage doors to arch springing. Watch man - night and day.

Remarks - Good safe accommodation.

2. Location - Under "Excelsior" building in Via Generale Orsini.

Accommodation - 15-20 vehicles space reserved.

Facilities - Garage being reconditioned following bomb damage. On completion: equipment to be moved in giving full workshop facilities for major repairs.

Security - Lock up. Watch man - night and day.

Remarks - On completion of repair works, the rear portion of the garage to be taken over by Sig. Bernuzzi, a garage proprietor. He states he has full garage workshop equipment, including plant and usual small equipment. Repairs to Genio Civile vehicles will be carried out under contract, now under negotiation. Sig. Bernuzzi also has a contract for repair of civilian vehicles used by Army. The workshop will not be in operation for at least another three weeks. No machinery has yet been moved in.

General - The proposed arrangements if carried into effect would be adequate to meet parking, garage and repair requirements for some time to come.
