2. I informed him that I understood that the matter was all settled and he asked if you would be good enough to let him have particulars of the settlement, as it was necessary for the army to keep closely in touch with the situation so that they could arrange for troops to take over in case of serious strike action by the workers.
3. Col. Crowdon, who was at the meeting, stated that the Naples Electrical Distribution men were on strike today and I stated that so far as I was aware A.C.C. had no knowledge of this.
4. I have since enquired from Region III and find that a meeting is being held at the Societa Meridionale di Elettricit 's offices today to discuss labour problems. It is unfortunate that Col. Crowdon made this statement at the meeting as all the members left with the impression that all the electrical workers in Naples were on strike, whereas I now understand that only a few workers stopped work this morning, and they have now gone back to work.

1. A recent unofficial letter from the Regional Commissioner, Region 5, states that:

"I cited in my 'Yoke' Sitrep a violation of rationing of food in Naples by purchases in Serracapriola black market of amassable foods (ground cecci and fava) to provide increased rations to employees of a corporation, involving Signori Furuzzi and Di Liete, agent and director respectively of the S. A. E. Meridionale (Southern Electric Co.) of Naples. The scheme aims to give increased rations to some 2000 electric employees and was put into effect apparently without the approval of the ACC Food Sub-Commission. Neither was the plan placed before Region V or Foggia Province for consideration.

Briefly, the scheme provides for purchase of amassable items with funds given to the agents by individuals of the S.A.E. company. Agents purchase direct from producers at black market prices, amassable food to the extent of 35000 kilos of cecci and 10,000 kilos of fava during March, at prices of approximately 3300 Lire and 1700 Lire per quintale, respectively. Food is transported by company transport from Foggia to Naples under permits issued by AMG Naples.

Should ACC approve this scheme, it is believed its privileges should be extended to all workers not so favored in other regions. This shunting practice is only one of several wherein unilateral action is taken without coOrdination through ACC or without considering the effect on other regions.

I wish to assure you that Region V is ready to carry out carefully.

TO : Economic Section.

1. A recent unofficial letter from the Regional Commissioner, Region 5, states that:

"I cited in my 'Yoke' Sitrep a violation of rationing of food in Naples by purchases in Serracapriola black market of amassable foods (ground cecci and fava) to provide increased rations to employees of a corporation, involving Signori Furuzzi and Di Liete, agent and director respectively of the S. I wish to assure you that Region V is ready to carry out carefully the policies of ACC as rapidly as they are enunciated and I report this shunting as a practice inimical to the best interests of ACC in its policy-fixing and control functions, whereby it watches and regularizes the pulse of the slowly reviving economic body of Italy and prevents unco-ordinated 'shots in the arm' here and there by well-meaning but non-consultative practitioners with a view to producing a minimum of disturbing reaction."

2. Reply is being delayed pending your comment on subject covered by the above quotation.

Food for S.M.E. Workers at Calore Generating Station

SME informed early Col Hensley first in all supply matter.
SME report Calore food matter settled 11/4/44

- 19th April. Request from Major Howe by telephone to Lt. Col. Lapper for food for 35 S.M.E. workers at Calore. Major Renton went to S.M.E. the same afternoon and saw S.M.E. Ration Requirements.
- 20th April. Major Renton saw Capt. Emery, Food Sub-Commission, who agreed to make all the necessary arrangements. Later in the morning, Major Renton spoke to Lieut. Colonel Hensley, to advise him of the situation. Colonel Hensley said that he believed that it was a regional matter and that he believed that it should be handled through his office. He asked that an SME representative visit him. Captain Emery was asked to defer all action, and Ing. Masturzo of SME was requested to apply to Colonel Hensley for food.
- 21st April. Ing. Masturzo informed Major Renton that he had tried all day to contact Colonel Hensley but that he had been unsuccessful.
- 22nd April. Heard no further information concerning food request.
- 24th April. Ing. Cucuolo, SME visited Major Renton. He had previously contacted Colonel Hensley (on the 24th April). Colonel Hensley had referred him to Lieut. Amburusi, Economics and Supply, Region III. Ing. Cucuolo appeared confused, did not know how much food he would receive, and was not clear as to what to do next. Major Renton telephoned Lieutenant Amburusi, and was told that the food would be granted if the request were submitted to Colonel Hensley and approved by him. To save time, Major Renton drafted a request for food to be presented to Colonel Hensley, and gave it to Ing. Cucuolo.
- 27th April. Major Howe (District III) telephoned Colonel Lapper re food for Calore workers indicating that the food still had not been received. Colonel Lapper telephoned Colonel Hensley who stated that all arrangements had been made. Colonel Lapper asked Major Howe to call at his office and discuss matters.
- Major Howe was met by Major Renton who telephoned Major Fitzgerald, Region III for information (Lieutenant Colonel Hensley was unavailable). Major Fitzgerald had no information, and referred Major Renton to Major Sealey, Food Control, Region II I. Majors Renton and Howe then visited Major Sealey who gave Major Renton a longhand note to the Supply Officer at Avellino authorizing supplementary rations for the Calore workers. Major Sealey stated that in the case of the workers taken there from Naples, it would only be necessary for them to hand their normal ration cards

to the Avellino Supply Officer who would issue normal rations. Major Renton subsequently advised Ing. Cuocuolo that a trip appeared necessary to Avellino on the following day. Ing Cuocuolo agreed to go.

26 April- Captain Freedy and Sergeant Anzivino of this Sub-Commission, and Ing. Cuocuolo visited Avellino and saw Lieut. Hartley, the A.M.C. representative in Avellino. Lieut. Hartley informed them that he had no knowledge of the SME request for food supply for Calore workers. Captain Freedy handed him the letter previously given Major Renton by Major Sealey, granting the supplementary rations for the workers. Lieut. Hartley agreed that issue could be made for the mid day meal but that he could not supply the normal rations without the matter being discussed with Lieut Colonel Merrill and Lieut. Colonel Hensley. (Lieut. Col. Merrill was described as the Region III Supply Officer).

Captain Freedy saw Lieut. Poole, R.E. Officer at the Calore plant, and told him that authority had been given to issue rations as described above. Lieut. Poole agreed to collect supplementary rations for food for SME workers at the plant, which were presently on the job as they were presently bringing their own food from home which does not include the heavy workers' ration.

Lieut. Poole informed Captain Freedy that Brig. Foley (CRE, Dist III) had visited the site (Calore) within the past few days and was informed of the lack of proper food arrangements. He stated that he would take the matter up himself.

Result

After waiting for ten days, there is still no proper arrangements for food supply. A most urgent job is being held up.
