1. With reference to your conversation with me regarding the supplementary food rations for the workers at Terni, this matter has been taken up with our Food Sub-Commission and their answer is as follows:-

" It is not possible to reclassify workers at Terni electrical plant for Scale "A" Supplementary rations. "

" All "B" workers now get exactly the same overall rations as prior to March 1st when the normal consumption was increased from 200 grams bread daily and 150 grams pasta weekly, to 200 grams bread daily and 550 grams pasta weekly. Supplementary rations were reduced to maintain the overall entitlement, in conformity with normal procedure. "

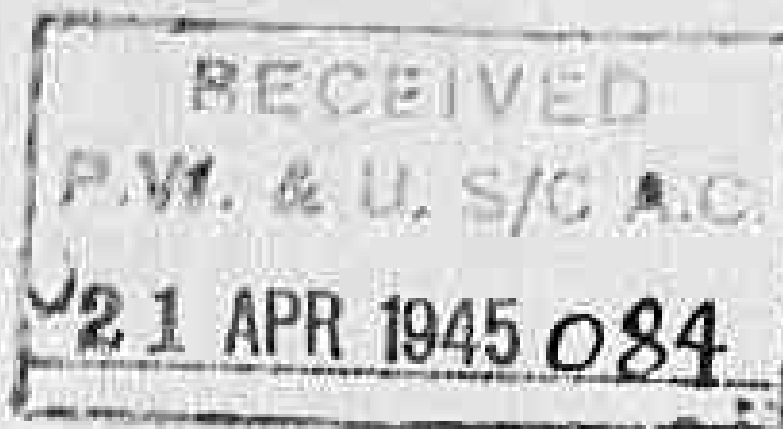
It should be recognized by the workers that their dependents have benefited considerably by the normal consumption increase. "

Concrete instances of non-availability of rationed foodstuffs in Terni areas should be reported to Provincial Supply Office for action and Food Sub-Commission. "

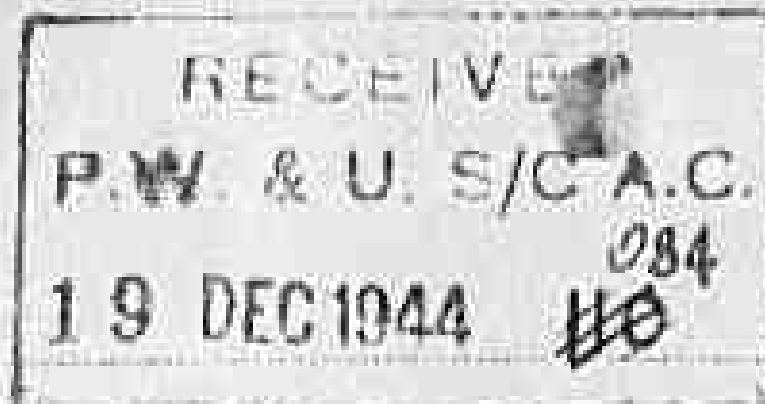

TO : Vice President, Economic Section, A.C.C.

1. I have discussed with you on several occasions the serious shortage of Italian engineers in occupied territory and that, while it is expected to augment the present staff to some extent when Rome is taken, it is expected that the best engineers who have held good positions during the last 20 years will have moved north with enemy forces. As a consequence, the Minister of Public Works discussed with me the possibility of repatriating engineers who are war prisoners of the Allies. I have agreed that, if possible, I be furnished with some names. I have just received a communication from the Minister in which he furnishes several names of engineers known to be war prisoners.

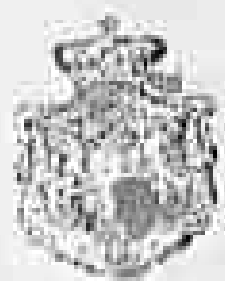

1. At the suggestion of Lt. Col. Smallwood we are requesting that the above named contractor and Electric Utility be given first priority at such a time any potatoes can again be released in the Rome Area. In good faith these parties purchased 39,21 quintals of potatoes at Avezzano and paid for same on 21 August 1944. After securing the necessary permits and gasoline the transportation broke down in September. During October attempts were again made to secure the necessary authority to move the potatoes and on 12 November with a special permit from this Headquarters the contractor attempted to move the potatoes and the potatoes were confiscated at Avezzano by Maj. Jenkins.

2. On 1 Nov. the Società Romana Eletticità had 164 men on the payroll and Contractor Montanari 75 men attempting to complete the difficult job of lining 2,000 metres of gallery so that the Canterno Hydro Plant could go into production with 10,000 KW for peak power on the Rome grid. Due to the shortage of flour in Frosinone Province the workers have not been receiving their supplemental rations of 100 grams of bread daily. This coupled with the disagreeable working conditions inside the gallery has made it difficult to keep men on this important work. The work is still generally on schedule but if an adequate food supply is not obtained at once the completion of Hydro Plant will be seriously delayed as the contractor is at the end of his resources.

3. We urgently request that the 2 parties mentioned above be given the status of privileged groups such as Cooperatives and Convivenza in order to purchase non-rationed products in the general vicinity of the construction project until the potatoes can be released. This work is scheduled to be completed in 3 months and your prompt consideration of this request will assist us in putting this important power project into production.-

3. The minimum rate which is 2200 Lire per ~~day~~ month will be paid for the first seven days, and may be increased commensurate with employee's skill and ability set out in para 2 above. It is policy of this Headquarters, as determined by the Civilian Personnel Policy Board, that salaries of civilian employees will be increased gradually, in accordance with their performance, rather than immediately increased to the maximum on completion of the seven day probationary period.

CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES' TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE

1. Establishment Memorandum Number 29, this headquarters, dated 2 November 1944, is hereby revoked.

2. Authority is given as from 1 November 1944, for the payment of travelling allowance to civilian employees of the Allied Commission, in respect of periods of absence from their headquarters or duty station.
