Sewers, Watersystems etc. A.Q. 400,1913 REENG.

To : Headquarters P.B.S. APO 782
Attention Lt. Col. L.F. Nickel A.G.D.

1. Reference is made to statements, which have been transmitted to this Sub-Commission, covering costs which have been incurred by P.B.S. in restoring various Utility services.

2. Discussions with the Finance Sub-Commission of A.C.C. bring out the fact that the settlement of costs incurred by the Allied Military and Naval forces falls within the province of high policy.

3. We are advised that, at the present time, no charges for military stores or services are to be made against the Italian Government. Such work together with all other work performed in Italy by the Allied Armies on Utility services, roads and other installations, may be considered later as a part of a wider financial settlement. Details should be put forward through your own financial channels.

4. Accordingly, there is no further need to report such charges to the Allied Control Commission.

5. Returned herewith are the statements which have been received from P.B.S. totaling \$1,003,422.78, together with a summary sheet, a copy of which is being retained in the office of this Sub-Commission.

1. Reference is made to your letter 30 April 44 pertaining to approximate value of services rendered to Italian authorities for the month of March 1944, in amount 26,250 pounds, and your letter 6 May 44 covering services in amount of 29,900 pounds for February 1944.

2. This matter has been discussed with Col. Crawshaw, Chief Accountant for A.C.C., who has called our attention to an understanding which he reached with Lt. Col. SUBJECT: Debts against Italian Govt. (Highways, etc.)

TO : Director,
Public Works and Utilities Sub-Commission.1. Reference your letter ACC/~~RS~~/PNU dated 28 April, 1944.

2. There appears to be some misunderstanding concerning the method of financing road construction and repair in liberated Italy.

3. At a meeting which you attended on 16 February, 1944, the Italian Government agreed to provide the funds necessary to repair roads, the work to be done by the AASS organization. However, work done on Italian roads by the Allied armed services is not to be charged against any specific Italian Government fund at this time. Such work, together with all other work performed in Italy by the Allied armies which has a permanent value, may be considered later as part of a wider financial settlement. Accordingly, the attached records of work performed on roads by PBS should be returned to that HQ.

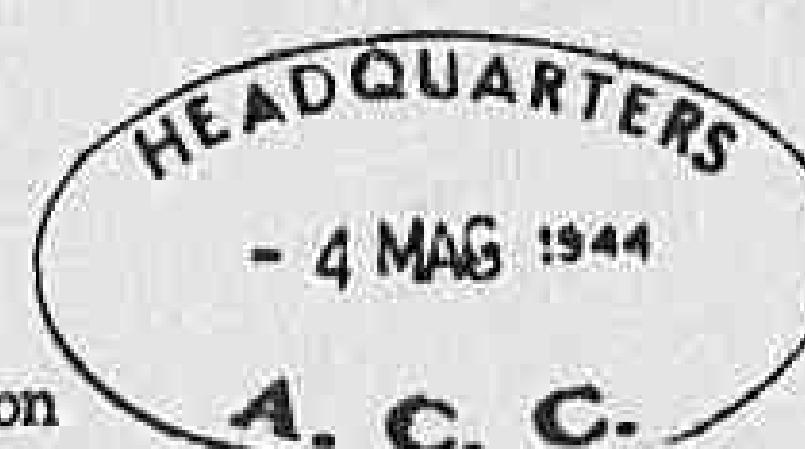

1. Inclosed is a record of costs to the United States for water system repair from 2 October 1943 to 20 April 1944 totaling \$12,448.00, accomplished by Engineer troops under Peninsular Base Section control.

2. It is requested that necessary steps be taken to debit the account of the Italian Government accordingly.

3. If, as understood, the Italian Government is required under the terms of the Armistice to pay the cost of all water consumed by the Allied Forces it follows that it should also be debited with the cost to the Allied Forces of all necessary repairs to the water system, even though privately owned. It is presumed that the Italian Government will, in turn, obtain reimbursement by deducting all such repair costs from invoices received from the water companies for water consumed by the Allied Forces.

4. It should be noted that in most cases repairs were of a permanent nature and while necessary to the military effort they also benefitted the civilian populace.

2. It is requested that necessary steps be taken to debit the account of the Italian Government accordingly.

3. If, as understood, the Italian Government is required under the terms of the Armistice to pay the cost of all electric power consumed by the Allied Forces it follows that it should also be debited with the cost to the Allied Forces of all necessary repairs to the power system, even though privately owned. It is presumed that the Italian Government will, in turn, obtain reimbursement by deducting all such repair costs from invoices received from the power companies for power consumed by the Allied Forces.

4. It should be noted that in most cases repairs were of a permanent nature and while necessary to the military effort they also benefited the civilian populace.

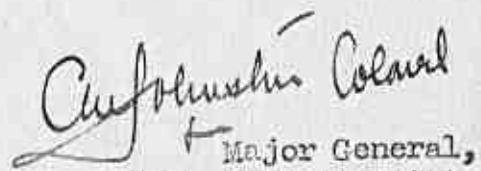

The Azienda Autonoma Statale Della Strada (A.A.S.S.), BARI have on the instructions of this H.Q. arranged that the urgent reconstruction works required on the FOGLIA Bye Pass from ORTA NOVA to BOVINA shall be executed by the firm of S.I.C.E.L.P., BARI at an estimated cost of Ten million and Eighteen thousand lire (10,018,000.00).
2. This road is of military importance as an L. of C. Convoy Route but it is at present closed to traffic owing to recent damage as a result of flooding and heavy military traffic.

The Azienda Autonoma Statele Della Strada (A.A.S.S.), BARI have on the instructions of this H.Q. arranged that the urgent reconstruction works required on the FOGGIA Bye Pass from ORTA NOVA to BOVINA shall be executed by the firm of S.I.C.E.L.P., BARI at an estimated cost of Ten million and Eighteen thousand lire (10,018,000.00).

2. This road is of military importance as an L. of C. Convoy Route but it is at present closed to traffic owing to recent damage as a result of flooding and heavy military traffic.

3. The estimate is considered to be reasonable.

4. As this road is a Provincial road not normally under the control of A.A.S.S. the latter organisation has no funds available to meet this expenditure. Will you, therefore, please arrange to make the necessary moneys amounting to L. 10,018,000.00 available to A.A.S.S. in seven equal weekly payments commencing 14 Feb 44.
