TO : Minister of Public Works.

1. I have a request from Dott. Pasquale Minuto, Segretario Particolare in your Ministry, asking for passes for yourself, Dr. Minuti, Dr. Basso and Dr. Schiavi and 2 autisti, namely Perri and Leursi. The request is made for these passes to permit this people to get an idea of the state of destruction caused in these territories.
2. I can understand why you, Signor Tiziano and some of his boy engineers may have occasion to go into advance Areas to make surveys as to destruction, but I do not know why Drs. Minuto, Basso and Schiavi would have occasion to engage in such tasks. I do not know that they are engineers qualified to make such inspections in AMG territory.
3. As we have been requested to limit such passes to a minimum, I would like to know first why these men would have to go into AMG territory, what their qualifications are and why the list does not cover such men as Tiziano and other engineers. I prefer to make one complete list of requests for such permits, but I would like to stress again that they must be kept to a minimum in number. It should also be remembered that these passes will only permit persons to go into territory turned over to AMG and not to go into territory still under the control of the Armies.

2. TRAVEL ORDERS:

Attention of all concerned is directed to pars 2 and 3, Administrative Order No. 3, this Hq, dtd 19 Nov 1943, subject: Travel Orders, which are amended to read as follows:

"2. Officers empowered to authorize journeys under par 1 above, will forward direct to the AG Publications at least 24 hours in advance, except in urgent cases, requests showing approval of the journey. The following information should be provided in the basic memo:

a. Name, rank, Army Serial Number, Sub-Commission, or Section to which assigned, and nationality of officers or EM/OR for whom the journey is authorized.

b. Destination.

c. State whether temporary or permanent change of station.

d. If on temporary duty, state the approximate length of time required.

e. Date of move.

f. Type of transportation desired (i.e. Air, Motor, or Water)

g. Brief statement of the mission.

Upon receipt of the request, the AG (Publications Section) will issue to the officer, or officers concerned, copies of the Special Orders, authorizing travel. Copies will also be sent to G-1, G-4, the Sub-Commission, Directorate, and Staff Section concerned. It will be the responsibility of the officer concerned to insure that travel arrangements are made with G-4 after publications of orders."
