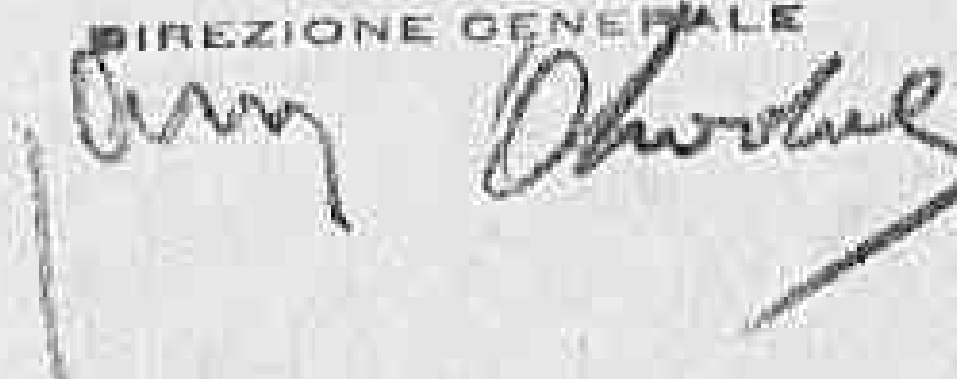

The Società Romana di Eletticità finds itself in the utmost necessity of sending to the North some of its managers on account of the following reasons:

- 1) Need of getting again in touch with its own financing Company (Sec. Centrale), whose seat is in Milan, via Gaetano Negri N°. 4, that is to say, with Ing. Francesco Cartasegna, who had taken to himself the concealment of materials and machinery which the Company had committed to the northern manufacturers and which were about to be delivered when the communications with Central Italy were stopped.
- 2) Agreements to be taken for the speedy supply of some parts of output machinery, destroyed by Germans, the manufacture of which encounters in Central Italy such difficulties that it is impossible to cope with them, although they have a vital importance for the putting again into operation of the Stations now on way of being restored.
- 3) On account of this it is necessary to get into touch with the following Firms: S. Giorgio and Ansaldo at Genoa; Savigliano at Turin; Brown Boveri, C.G.E., Marelli, Riva and Tosi at Milan, as well as Calzoni at Bologna.
- 3) Need of purchasing, if ready, or to order some electrical meters and time-switches of which Central Italy is completely devoid, as well as electrical cables and insulated conductors.

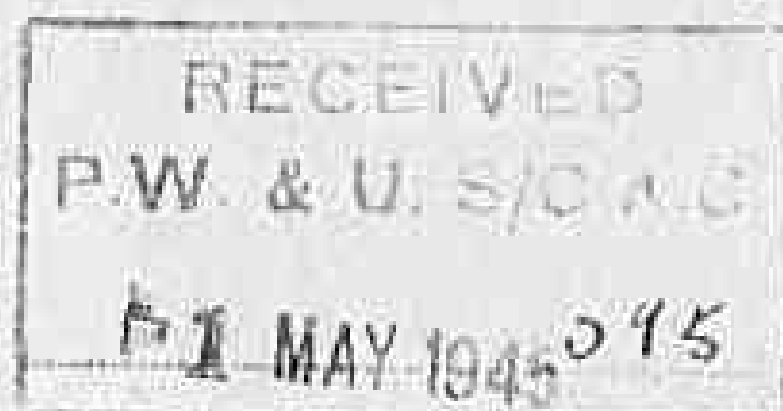

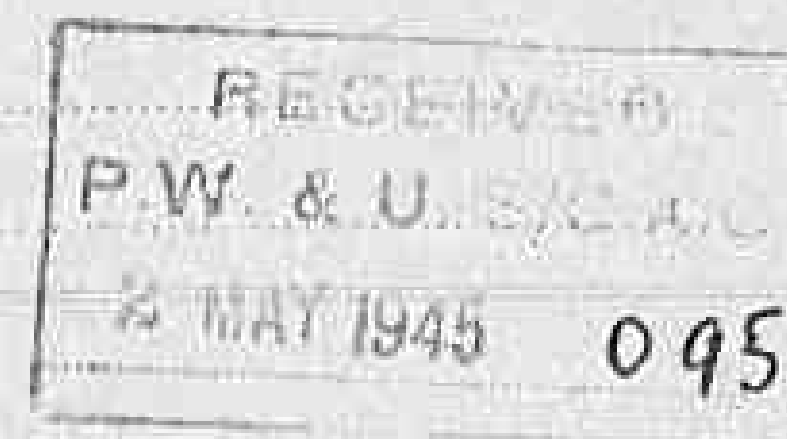

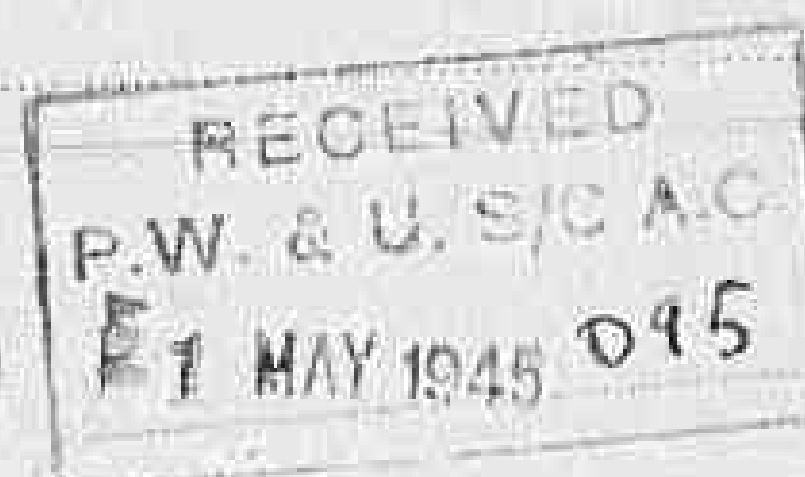

SUBJECT: Transport.

TO : Vice President, Establishments Section.

1. Owing to the rapid advances into North Italy, the Dispatch Office is receiving many applications for trips into that area and is likely to receive many more. Up to date all trips have been met but it is anticipated that vehicles will be away for longer periods, and, owing to the shortage of vehicles capable of undertaking such trips, it is recommended that a priority scheme should be introduced. It is not possible for the Dispatch Office to say what trips are more important than others and, therefore, can only operate on the principle of first come, first serve, according to the availability of vehicles for the particular trips involved.

2. Would it be possible, therefore, for Vice Presidents of Sections to be asked that all trips into Northern Italy should be passed through the respective offices and priority given by the Vice President's office concerned so that the Dispatch Office can then operate in fairness to each Section and Sub-Commission.
