We here held these awaiting delivery of truck which we have had on order with Fiat works since August 1945. We have just received this truck which is a 626/NL bearing chassis No. 011091, Motor No. 016632 and bearing Rome license No. 90216.

Since the tires are of U.S. manufacture and are used tires from surplus war stocks, we need a certificate authorizing their use on the above truck.

 - c) Chassis number of the vehicle.
 - d) Type of vehicle.
 - e) Trade number of the tyres fitted to the vehicle.
 - f) Circulating permit number of the vehicle.

These particulars must be registered before authority can be issued to use the tyres purchased by you.

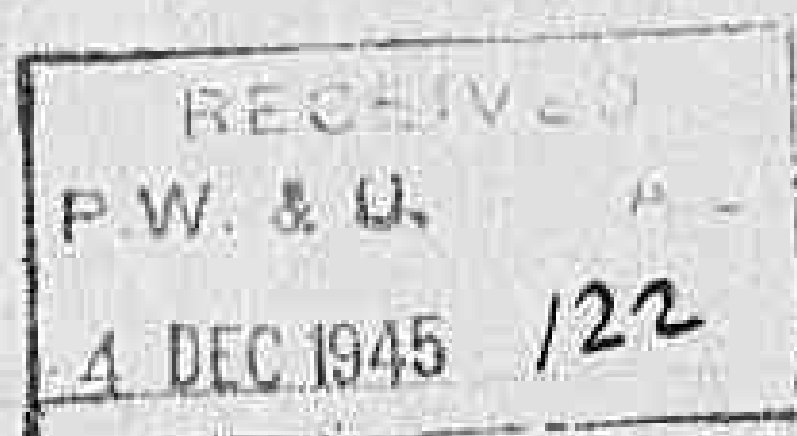

Con riferimento al foglio 2719 del 22.II.1945 di codesto Ministero si fa presente che i fabbisogni di carburante dei Truck-Pools di Chieti e Pescara vengono tenuti in particolare considerazione dalle rispettive Direzioni Provinciali dell'ENAC, le quali, normalmente, assegnano ai Truck-Pools stessi circa il 40% di tutto il quantitativo di benzina a loro disposizione; detto quantitativo è insufficiente a soddisfare tutte le richieste di trasporto della provincia; ma ciò dipende da una situazione generale dovuta alla persistente scarsità di carburanti.

Naturalmente se gli autocarri dei Truck-Pools vengono impiegati per l'effettuazione di trasporti più urgenti, rispetto a quelli richiesti dalla S.M.E., questi ultimi devono subire, necessariamente, dei differimenti.

Con l'occasione si precisa che qualora gli autocarri del Truck-Pools non possano effettuare i trasporti per esaurimento delle assegnazioni di carburante le richieste di trasporto potranno essere rivolte alle Direzioni Provinciali ENAC che, compatibilmente alle disponibilità di carburante, possono mettere a disposizione anche autocarri di altri trasportatori.

Comunque è opportuno che gl'incaricati della S.M.E. a Chieti e a Pescara prendano gli opportuni contatti con le locali Direzioni Provinciali ENAC onde definire l'effettivo fabbisogno della predetta Società, fabbisogno che verrà poi segnalato a questa Direzione Generale che lo prenderà nella dovuta considerazione per le assegnazioni future di benzina alle provincie di cui trattasi.

With reference to letter 2719 of 22 Nov 45 of the Ministry of Public Works, we point out that the requirements of P.O.I. for the Truck Pools of Chieti and Pescara are given special consideration by the ENAC Provincial Directions who, as a rule, allocate to the a/m pools about 40% of the total quantity of gasoline they have available. This quantity is not sufficient to meet all request for transport in the province, but this is depending upon a general situation due to the persistent shortage of petrol.

Naturally, if the Truck-Pool vehicles are employed on more urgent jobs than those for S.M.E., these latter will necessarily suffer some delay.

We also point out that, when the Truck-Pools vehicles are unable to carry out transport owing to depletion of P.O.I. stocks, the requests for transport may be addressed to the Provincial Directions of ENAC who, provided petrol is available, will supply vehicles belonging to other transport agencies.

In any way, it is advisable that the S.M.E. officials at Chieti and Pescara make appropriate arrangements with the local Provincial Directions of ENAC in order to determine the actual requirements of the Company, which will then be transmitted to this Direction General who will give it their due consideration in view of the future allotments of P.O.I. to the Provinces in question.

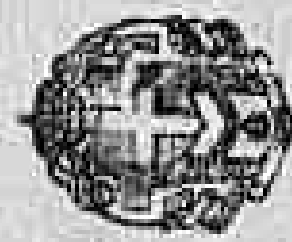

La Soc. Meridionale di Elettricità per i lavori di ricostruzione che ha in corso al 3° e 4° salto del Pescara noleggiò autocarri presso i truck pools di Pescara e di Chieti -

In data 16 c.m. la Ditta ha avuto comunicazione da Pescara che i detti truck pools hanno sospeso l'invio degli autocarri per mancanza di benzina -

I lavori sono, in conseguenza, praticamente fermi, 700 operai vengono pagati senza poter lavorare -

Risulterebbe che i truck pools hanno solo benzina per la 1° quindicina del mese in dipendenza della riduzione delle assegnazioni globali al Governo Italiano e che questa situazione tende a peggiorare.

Nell'interesse della ricostruzione degli impianti a Pescara della Soc. Meridionale Elettr., impianti i quali portano un notevole contributo all'economia del paese si preano vivamente gli Enti in indirizzo a volere intervenire perchè sia concessa una assegnazione straordinaria di benzina che consenta il prosieguo dei lavori.

Questo Ministero reputa, poi, che dal punto di vista più generale sarebbe veramente indispensabile riconoscere una priorità per i lavori interessanti l'industria elettrica, in maniera di evitare che casi simili possano ripetersi in danno di importanti altre Società elettriche espletanti lavori di interesse nazionale.-

The Società Meridionale Elettricità is loaning trucks from the truck pools at Pescara and Chieti for the works they have underway at 3rd and 4th Head of Pescara.

On Nov 16 a/m Company was informed that the truck pools had suspended dispatch of trucks owing to lack of petrol.

As a consequence, works are practically stopped, and 700 idle workers are being paid.

It would seem that the truck pools have petrol for the first half of the month only, as a consequence of the cut in the bulk allocations to the Italian Government, and that the situation is getting worse.

In the interest of the reconstruction of Pescara Plants of S.M.E., which can give a noteworthy contribution to the civilian economy, we beg the Agencies to whom this letter is addressed to take this matter up, and arrange for a special fuel allocation allowing recommencing of works.

Furthermore, we are of the opinion that, from the general viewpoint, it would be really essential to give priority to the works connected with electrical industry, in order to prevent that other similar cases may occur and cause inconvenience to other Electric Companies who are carrying out works of national interest.
