Period covered - 1st May to 1st Sep 45.

Public Works Division

MAY. 400 Communal Housing Committees organised and functioning. 17,739 Housing repair projects commenced and 8,573 completed. Value of work on Housing to end of May 1,859 million lire. Total numbers of bridges completed 1,652.

JUNE. Housing Committees functioning now total 433. Housing repair projects commenced now total 24,344 and a total of 12,646 have been completed. Value of work on Housing to end of June now totals 2,542 million lire.

A comprehensive five year rehabilitation program for the Port of Genova was submitted for consideration at a total cost of 950 million lire. Approval was given for the initial urgent work which can be completed in 1945 amounting to 95 million lire.

JULY. During this month additional projects were approved for the rehabilitation work at the Ports of Genova, Savona, La Spezia, Apuania, Viareggio and Ancona. Activities were hampered somewhat by mine clearance operations but in general progress was satisfactory. A total of 1,761 bridges had been completed at the end of July.

All Public Works activities in Emilia Region and in the Provinces of Lucca and Apuania were handed over to the Italian Government.

AUGUST. A total of 1,932 bridges had been completed in Italy by the end of August.

Final arrangements have been made for a complete turnover of operation of all equipment, shops and machinery maintenance facilities to the Italians by 1 October with representatives of the Sub-Commission to function in an advisory capacity only.

A Housing Officer has been attached to the Sub-Commission Headquarters to work directly with the Italian Ministry Officials to expedite the Housing rehabilitation program.

May. The Master Control Center in Rome continues to satisfactorily control the power plants and transmission systems in Central Italy. Initiated by the Electrical Division of this Sub-Commission it will remain as a permanent organization in the development of the Italian Electrification.

Regular Meetings of the Italian Advisory Committees on Electric Power continued to be held in Sardinia, Sicily, Southern and Central Italy. The Central Italy advisory Committee were advised by Allied Commission to give serious consideration to the raising of the frequency from 45 to 50 cycles throughout Central Italy to enable them to take additional power from Northern Italy at similar frequency when available.

The Committee recommended that this be done. A similar recommendation was made to the Southern Italy Advisory Committee. After an inspection of the Electrical power situation in Northern Italy and discussion with the Electrical Companies it was found that ample power existed for the whole of the Northern area. About 10% of the generating plants were damaged and the majority of these can be repaired within 3 months. Agreement to furnish the French with a limited amount of power from generating stations within the Liguria area occupied by them resulted in the return of these stations to their rightful owners and it is not considered that this loss of power will be detrimental to the industrial situation for the present as the demand for power is less than normal.

Further discussions were held on the conversion of frequency in Central and Southern Italy from 45 to 50 cycles. Central Italy expects to convert at the end of July 45 and Southern Italy in December 45.

During the month these 60,000 Volt Transmission Lines capable of transporting 20,000 K.W. power from Northern to Central Italy were completed and put into operation.

The Chief of the Electrical Division was appointed a member of the Mission to meet with the Yugoslav Mission for the purpose of recommending procedures for industrial and financial relations between the areas under the jurisdiction of the Allies and the Yugoslav Government.

July. Two new and important Committees were formed and met during July; one comprising representatives of Electrical Industry for Northern Italy and the other composed of representatives of the Sardinia, Sicily, Southern, Central and Northern Italy Advisory Committees. This body is known as the National Advisory Committee on Electrical Power for Italy and will advise the Italian Government.

On the 22nd July the Central Italy Grid System operated at 50 cycles and no difficulties were encountered during this trial period.

August. On the recommendation of this Sub-Commission an allocation of ~~15,000~~ ^{15,000} KW was made to the Terni Chemical Works at Nero Montoro. This Company produce badly needed chemicals and fertilizers and has now been able to commence operations.

As and from the 27 August the Central Italy Grid System operated at 50 cycles.

The third 35,000 KW generating unit at the Galleto plant at Terni was restored to operation making a total of 105,000 KW repaired at this plant during the past ten months. A second 120,000 Volt line was completed linking Northern Italy with the Florence-Pistoia-Leghorn Area, of Central Italy. This makes a total of five lines completed since the liberation of the Northern Regions and 60,000 KW of power is now being transported over these lines at 50 cycle frequency.
