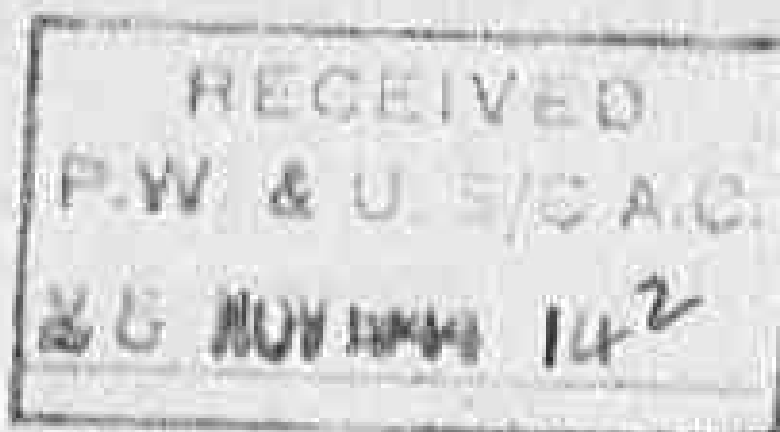

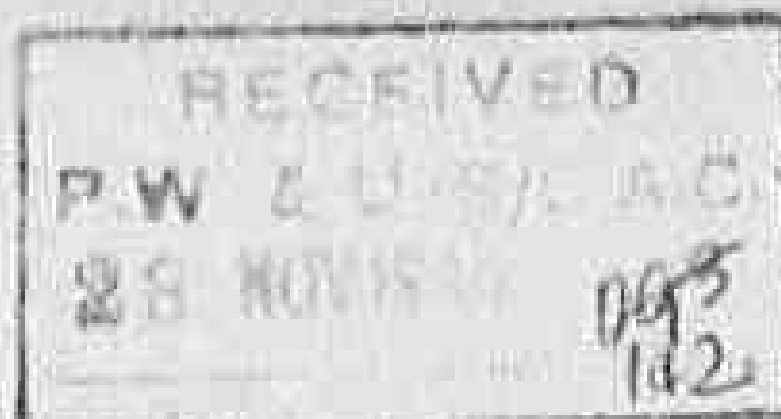

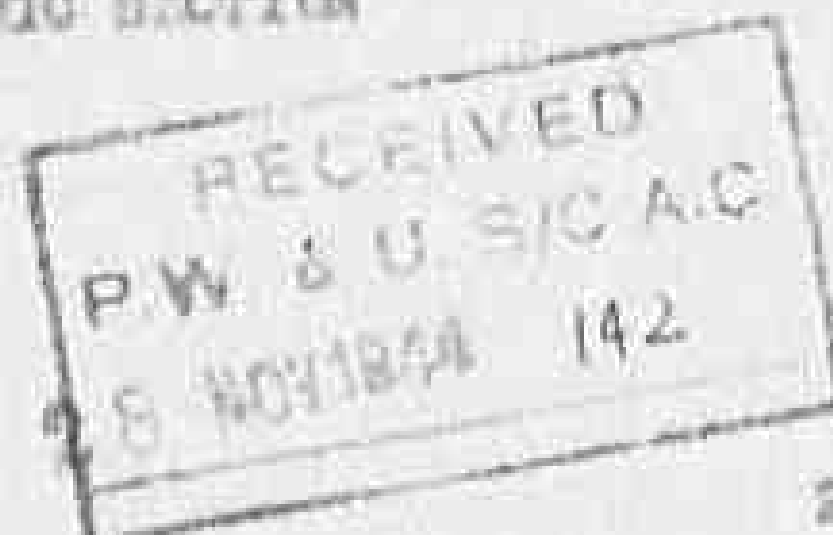

1. Reference is made to the following relative to subject item:
 - a. Letter AFHQ G-5 Section, Reference M-6, dated 27 October 1944.
 - b. CAL 905, 27 October 1944
 - c. CAL 969, 19 November 1944.

2. Replies to above referred correspondence were delayed pending the arrival of Lt. Col. W. M. Lapper from the United States with whom the subject of candles was discussed. We have learned from Col. Lapper that his conversations with COAC officials were confined to the electricity supply situation and that the question of furnishing candles for Italy came only after conversations had been concluded with reference to availability of electricity in Southern Italy.

3. We do not agree with statement in CAL 841 referred to in Paragraph 3 of your letter of 27 October 1944 that on the basis of electric facilities for lighting available south of Naples no candles should be required for that area. The assumption seems to be that if electric light exists in certain districts, candles are unnecessary. This ignores the fact that a very substantial number of houses are without electric light and have always been so. No consideration appears to be given to the frequent failures in power which plunge whole cities into darkness. It also ignores the fact that many houses having used kerosene lamps for lighting purposes find it difficult to obtain kerosene, except in some instances in the black market and at terrifically high prices. In addition, Calabria which is rural with scattered towns and villages electric light is not available to many of the inhabitants who must rely on candles. It is of interest to note that a failure at Sila, has caused 45,000 KW to be lost so that at this time complete absence of candles in Meridional Italy would be disastrous.

4. There remains in Italy at the present moment only about 600 tons of paraffin wax, of which certain quantities must be reserved for essential

match manufacture and for other essential industrial purposes. Candle manufacture will, therefore, cease on or before 15 December 1944.

5. It is strongly urged that delivery of candles be made against requisition. The amounts requested are not excessive but modest and represent only essential needs.

6. Military necessity, it would appear, lies in the importance of avoiding unrest in districts occupied by the Armed Forces, caused by the absence of any sort of illumination in many areas. Much propaganda against the Allies is based upon the assertion that the amenities of life have been drastically reduced since the Germans were evicted, and little weight is given by those who have no knowledge of the real facts that this is due to acts of Italy's late Allies.

SUBJECT: Warehouse Procedures on Incoming Civilian Supplies

FROM: Shipment, Port & Warehouse Division

TO: Director, Sub-Commissions (see distribution)

1. According to presumably established procedure, the Requisition Division notifies the various Sub-Commissions of impending arrivals of incoming civil supplies. The Sub-Commission then is required to notify this Division promptly of desired disposition.

2. Recent experience indicates that in the majority of cases it is necessary for this Division to pursue the Sub-Commissions diligently to obtain needed information regarding disposition. Frequently it appears that Sub-Commissions are uncertain of desired disposition. The time lag caused by the delay in reaching a decision creates a problem in this Division due to the necessity of promptly issuing orders to Port & Warehouse Officers where ships have either arrived or are about to arrive.

3. Frequently incomplete instructions are received. E.G. "Ship to Naples", giving no method of shipment, no name of consignee, and no street address. Instructions are also received which are impossible to follow, and which show a complete lack of understanding of the problem.

4. Further, despite general information that certain supplies are urgently needed, experience indicates they frequently remain in warehouses for what appears to be an extended period.

5. It is hoped that Directors of Sub-Commissions will bring the matter to the attention of the individuals involved in their own organizations. Detailed procedures were previously advised in mimeograph letter 25 Oct 44, Subject: Disposition of Imported Civil Supplies.

and Lt. Col. W.M. Lapper (Br.) in Accordance with Signals
WX 30499 of 14 Sept. and LAC 709 of 24 Sept.

TO : All concerned

1. In accordance with cable from CCS to General Wilson, No. WX 30499 of 14 September 1944, Lt. Cols. L.A. Jenny (U.S.) and W.M. Lapper (Br.) of the Public Works and Utilities Sub-Commission, A.C.C., will proceed to Washington on temporary duty for the purpose of presenting a requisition and supporting data with a view to obtaining approval for plant to be sent to Italy, as follows:

Requisition Ref MES-216-Eng. This is a flexible requisition, asking for electric power units of certain types, according to availability, not to exceed 60,000 KW.

This requisition has been approved by AFHQ, under the current interpretation of the term "military requirements", with the following provision:

- (a) As an urgent requirement for such portions as may be available for delivery, installation and effective utilization during the period of military responsibility.
- (b) As a basis for future planning by such civilian agencies as will be charged with the responsibility for relief and rehabilitation in Italy after the military responsibility has been completed.

These officers are authorized by this H.Q. to accept whatever combination of such plants as may be available and fit into the Italian electrical rehabilitation scheme, up to the total KW asked for in the requisition.

2. These officers are also authorized to discuss Requisition No. MES-180-Eng, which was approved by AFHQ on 15 June 44, and take all possible steps to expedite action thereon.

4. There have now been organized 8 Legions of Finance Guards the duties of which are to collect customs and taxes and to conduct operations against smuggling and black-market. Two of these Legions are in Region I. The average strength of a Legion is about 1,000 men.

5. There are also 10 Legions of civil police (two each in Regions I and VI) whose duties are to maintain law and order and to maintain a constant guard at various parts of distribution of materials and supplies for both military and civilian. The average strength of a Legion is about 1,100 men.

6. Flashlights to be used for the above, mentioned functions will be distributed daily only to those officials performing night duty. They will be turned in each morning for redistribution the same evening. It is not contemplated that certain officials will be in permanent possession of flashlights.

7. In connection with flashlights for public utilities, the ANI Public Works and Utilities Subcommission has determined a need of 800 (400 for Naples, and 400 for Rome). These are to be distributed to public utilities companies and are an operational necessity for watchmen, inspectors, and emergency and safety crews in maintaining water, gas and electrical utilities of the cities of Naples and Rome. These utilities are important not only for the civilian population but also for the military population and military installations in and around these cities.

8. In general, flashlights are urgently needed by all classes of officials and other persons referred to in this justification. Police officials, Finance guards, and carabinieri performing their nightly duty are forced to labor in total darkness because of black-out regulations or for lack of lighting facilities. Public utilities servicemen require flashlights in carrying out their normal duties where light is not accessible or performing emergency repair work much of which is done at night.

2. The system employed by this headquarters in channeling civil supply requisitions is based on procedure followed in a theatre supply headquarters; that is :

a. Overall requisitions for civil supplies for a definite period of time (six months) are received from the field (in this case, the regions) by the headquarters coordinating agency (the Regulation Division).

b. The Regulation Division forwards all regional overall requisitions to subcommissions for screening of items and amounts listed. Subcommissions extract data on each of the items in which they are concerned, and, on the basis of all regional requests received, submit to the Regulation Division requisitions for either (1) overall requirements of an entire industry, or (2) overall requirements for a particular commodity.

c. The Regulation Division screens and edits the requisitions received from the subcommissions, coordinates such requisitions with other subcommissions and sections concerned, and submits overall requisitions to G-3, AFM.

3. The following other comments are pertinent:

a. The Regulation Division does not initiate requisitions. The Regulation Division will, however, request subcommissions to submit requisitions when some plan or program adopted by the Economic Section calls for materials.
