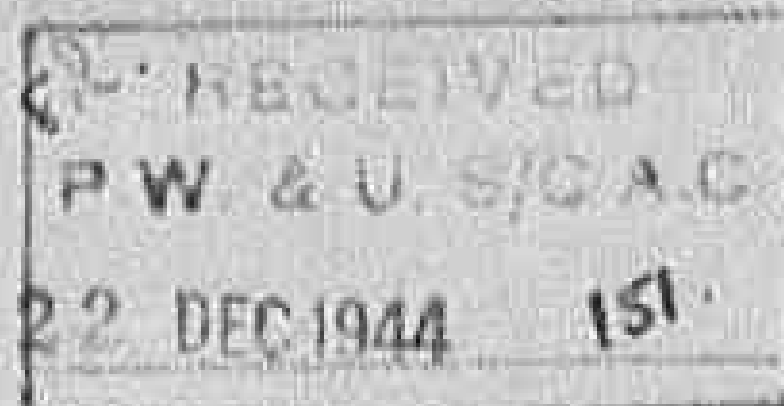

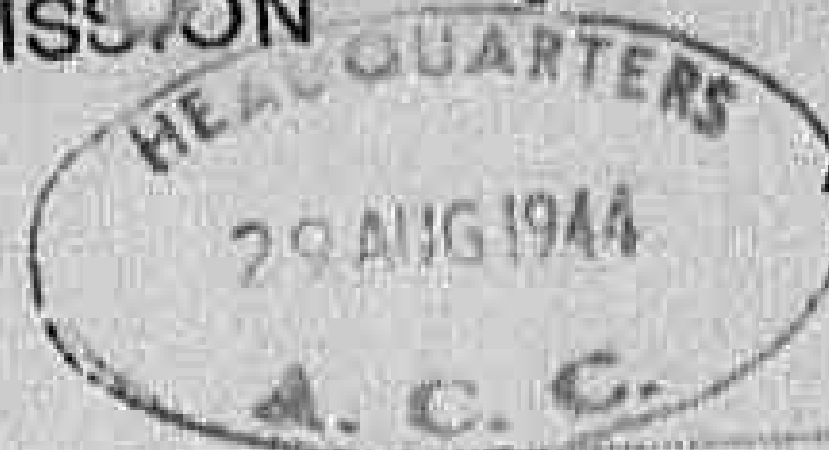

ROME REGION; This region is different from other regions due to its size and compactness. Each section of the Region is available from the office in an hour motor drive. However due to its political and social significance many Generals and high ranking officers have moved here. In other words we are suffering "brass hot trouble". When Rome was occupied hundreds of motor vehicles were found. These were given temporary licenses and put to work. This was especially true of trucks. No fuel was issued during the first weeks and all movement was by local fuel stocks or captured fuel supplies taken by Italians. Fuel is now being issued in very limited quantities.

The local Gas people started up the Gas Works when we came in. After one week of operation this was shut down as we needed the coal for electric power plants. The furnaces are being kept warm. However Rome is critically short of fuel and flour pasta and food cannot be cooked in the houses. Gas should be turned on when possible. The fuel has been requested and is available at Naples awaiting transport.

Col. Jenny: When will the Fiumicino port be cleared?

The work is progressing but has been slowed up due to lack of transport and fuel. In about four weeks it is hoped that coal can be brought into the harbour for Rome.

The RAAC British and American Engineers have pooled their resources with AEC Engineers. This has helped work tremendous and avoided duplicating of effort and misunderstanding.

Power situation is that we are now getting 15,000 Kw from the Hydro-electric plants. The remaining power is furnished by the local steam plants. Due to low water it was necessary to build a dam over the Tiber. A strict rationing scheme is now in use for electric power in Rome.

In Rome and vicinity there are numerous brick & pottery plants. This material should be available for use to the south on back haul by the R.R. and should help the material situation.

In Rome Region motor cars were licensed and a number was stencilled on each car. This helped a lot.

MEETING OF REGIONAL ENGINEERS 12 June 1944.

itemo.

The following were the main ~~points~~ ^{items}. Reference should be made to the agenda covering 16 points which was prepared for the meeting. Regional Engineers will, of course, have taken their own personal notes on the points discussed and decisions reached:-

1. Para. 3 of agenda, suggested sections and titles; ~~was~~ agreed to.
2. Agreed that para. 4 can be complied with, plans to be initiated by Regional Engineers now. (equipment, maintenance etc.)
3. On Para. 5 (monthly reports) agreed that these must cover up to the 25th of each month, at any rate, and if possible even a few days later in each month. In any event to be at Offices of Sub-Commission by first of each month, and in no event later than 2nd of each month. Agreed that general form of reports can follow that set out by the note (GEV/ocb dated 12 June) prepared by Deputy-Director, of which each Regional Engineer took a copy. Any major points in these reports to be brought forward by Regional Engineers at first subsequent meeting.
4. Re para. 6, next monthly meeting will be on Monday, 24 July.
5. (a) Turning to suggested outline of procedure (copies with each Regional Engineer). Para. 1 (b) relating to Genie Civile and C.R.E's. No precise decision arrived at, but agreed that Regional Engineers should know extent and nature of calls made on Genie Civile by C.R.E's, as a general rule. Suggested that if C.R.E's would make these requests in writing and not verbally, sending a carbon copy to the Regional Engineer, this might meet requirements. If this fails to work, then matter to be brought up again at July meeting when Director may consider getting Chief Engineers of Districts to give orders to that effect. *[Matter has already been referred to in a letter to D. W. since the meeting.]*
- (b) On point raised by Major Knight and others that C.R.E's may not be clear as to A.C.C. and Regional Engineers' functions, the sooner Regional Engineers talk the matter over with the C.R.E's and make it clear, the better.
- (c) Regarding the 600,000,000 lire fund for military highways, it was suggested that any project coming reasonably within its scope could be debited against that fund. This involves a slightly different procedure as already indicated, but it may tend to expedite getting work done.

(d) As to 2(g) in the agenda, Lt.Col. Hensley suggested that ~~normal~~ bridge loads, in tons, should be posted ~~on~~ ^{ask that} on as many bridges as possible. *agreed.*

(e) As to 2(j), Lt.Col. Jenny said he would ~~advise~~ ^{ask that} the Regional Commissioners ~~advise~~ ^{ask that} their Provincial Commissioners not to call on Genie Civile for plans, estimates, etc., except through Regional Engineers. *(Letter of 13 June to Reg Supr, par 7, asks Reg Supr to re 7519, Reg Com to do so)*

(f) As to Para. 4 procedure, and a point raised by Lt. Col. Hensley, it was made clear that transport for military highways ~~never~~ is on no account to be used for any other purpose. Lt. Col. Jenny promised to take this matter up, also, through Regional Commissioners. (See letter to Reg. Engr. 13 June 1944 par. 15 and 6) Reg. Engr.

(g) Regarding ordering of materials, Para. 5 procedure, Lt. Col. Hensley said that at least 7 days should be allowed or preferably 10 days between receipt of release note and the actual collection of the materials. Transport difficulties, etc. may occur (Lt. Col. Lapper to look into this).

(h) As to contracts being dealt with exclusively through Italian channels but which may require controlled equipment or materials, Major Knight explained his point of view and submitted a suggested form. This matter is being investigated by Lt. Col. Lapper.

(i) As to disparity in issue scales for POL (A.C.C. 1200 and A.F.H.Q. 600 per week, etc.) Lt. Col. Thompson to discuss this with Director of Works.

6. Referring to a possible drastic diminution in the number of Regional Engineers' staffs in the not distant future, Lt. Col. Jenny suggested employment by Regional Engineers of qualified Italian Engineers at rates say up to 300 lire per day, but in no case to exceed 8000 lire per month. These rates, it must be understood, apply only to fully qualified civil engineers and not to draughtsmen or to people in lower categories. Such a staff would not be debited against any T/O or W/E. Draughtsmen might be paid up to 170 lire a day as a maximum.

7. As to personnel, Lt. Col. Lapper will address Regional Engineers officially, through the Regional Commissioners, as to the duties of certain officers, e.g. Capt. Ryan, Majors Hyland and Hasic or any others. Similarly, Director will notify Regional Commissioners of the officers in the various Regions working on Regional Engineers' staffs who may be considered to be on temporary duty; not to be employed in any other capacity. (See letter to Reg. Engr. 13 June 1944 par. 4 & 6. Reg. Engr. to advise their Commissioners)
