Subject: Estimates damage to dwellings -
letter of Lt.Col. Latimer to Lt.Col.

TO : Regional Commissioner, Marche - Abruzzi.
(Att: Regional Engineer)

1. In Regional Engineer's letter a figure of \$2,271,300,000 was mentioned as " tentatively accepted by P.W.&U.S/C" for approximate damage cost of private dwellings in all Italy. Also, a total of \$2,694,000,000 was similarly quoted to cover all damage to both private dwellings plus all other public works.

2. Our records of July and August 1944 monthly reports (and also the A.C.C., August 1944 monthly report) show our approx. est., for all public works plus private building damage to be \$2,704,000,000 but this total was split up into \$1,216,000,000 for private dwellings and the balance was for all other public works. We suggest that Lt.Col. Andrews be informed of this correction.
