SUBJECT: ACC Representative at HQ AAI.

TO :

*Capt. Puddy**Start a new file on this*

1. ACC representative will minister only to the immediate urgent needs of Army AMGs and forward regions.

2. Policy

Army AMGs and forward Regions will continue to work and take their directions from ~~Head~~ in HQ ACC.

3. Main HQ ACC will keep the representative at AAI fully advised as regards the overall policy in order that he may at all times be in a position to meet urgent demands and give decisions on urgent requirements.

4. The representative at AAI is not a Headquarters and, therefore, must not be placed in the position by Army AMGs and forward Regions of
(a) having to deal with every matter that arises

or

(b) becoming merely a post office.

Communications therefore, will continue to be sent to ACC Main and only in matters of extreme urgency will they be repeated for action to representative AAI.

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5. A great deal of the work of representative AAI will be by personal contact with AAI, Army AMGs, forward Regions and HQ ACC. HQ AAI will naturally turn to ACC representative in all its dealings with AMG and ACC.

ACC representative will have authority to make decisions on urgent matters which affect forward areas only, with direction to report such decisions immediately to HQ ACC.

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Army ARMs and forward Regions will continue to seek and take their directions from HQ ACC.

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6. AAJ representative will have the following staff:-

- a. (Administration Section)
- b. (Economic Section)
- c. (Food Sub-Commission)
- d. (Transportation Sub-Commission)
- e. (Labor Sub-Commission)
- f. (P.A. to representative)

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7. All requests from HQ ACC for travel into AOC Army areas will be addressed to ACC representative. All requests by Army units and regions within AAI territory for personnel to be sent forward will be addressed to ACC representative.

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
