1. The selection of Major Knight for the Chief of the Industry & Utilities S/O for the Northwest Region was based on his excellent ability, that he has volunteered for additional duty and on his current knowledge of the northern areas. Several weeks ago, he made an inspection trip of the various Regional Engineers headquarters to familiarize himself with the works in progress, to arrange for certain records to be transferred to the Milan office then contemplated as the Office of the Special Representative of the Chief Commissioner.

2. Public Works officers are personnel of the Public Works and Utilities Dept. consequently can and are assigned according to the best interests of the operations in general. However Regional Commissioners are usually advised of contemplated changes and reasons.

They are to deal with them as with any other employees of their staff. While such civilian personnel is to be assigned to the duties in which they are specialists they are also to be assigned to such additional duties as the Director of the respective Sub-Commission may direct.
4. If the addition of any such personnel to the staff of a Sub-Commission requires an increase in the ceiling of the Sub-Commission, appropriate request for an increase in such ceiling should be made to the Man-Power and Re-organization Committee through the Economic Section.

Further to my interview with you of yesterday, and in view of the unfavorable reports regarding my work as Food Officer, it would appear that I am quite unsuited for this work.

When I was interviewed at the War Office I was selected on my qualifications and experience in the Building Trade and was then informed that I would proceed to Wimbeldon to undergo a course of training. However, a few days later I received instructions to proceed to the Centre at London for embarkation without receiving any training. When I arrived at North Africa, I was assigned to Economics and Supply.

May I, therefore, state briefly my industrial experience, viz.

I studied Building Construction in the Royal Technical College, Glasgow, and Architecture in the Glasgow School of Art, obtaining certificates in both colleges. I also secured The City Guilds of London Institute Certificate (Department of Technology) in Building Construction.

For over 14 years I was lecturer in the above subject in the Clydebank Technical School and for five years in the Greenock Technical College.

From 1920 until 1934 I was manager in charge of the Sawmill and Woodworking Departments of the Singer Manufacturing Co., Ltd., Kibowle, leaving to commence business on my own account as a Building Contractor and was engaged in this work when I was called up in 1939.

On leaving hospital after my recent illness, I was medically boarded and down-graded to "B" with a further recommendation that, as I was still suffering from fibrosis of my right lung, if possible, I should be employed on base duty somewhere in the Naples or Rome area as the climate was more suitable for my complaint. I am quite prepared to undertake any duties which may be allotted to me at any time. May I respectfully request you to review my case, even if it means my transfer to another Sub-Commission where my qualifications and experience will be of more value.

From my mission for you to study the situation of electrical engineering in the Region and to discuss these with Major Foden who will be in the Region. It is most important that there be proper team work and I look for your suggestions.

1. At the suggestion of the Director of Public Works and Utility Sub-Commission I am relieving you of other duties in connection with Public Works and Utilities in order that you may devote your entire time to Electrical questions in the Region; including, rationing to users, also rehabilitation of plants and transmission lines and other problems that may arise in connection therewith.

This will include attendance at conferences, close contact with civilian electrical officials, an intensive survey of field conditions and study for and report on rehabilitation.

2. Major Bennett will be left in Chieti for the present to continue supervision of and assistance on repairs and reconstruction in Abruzzi Compartimento, at present under way.

3. Capt. Walsh will take over your other Public Works duties in Marche Compartimento and Engineer Milani assisted by Major Bennett will take over Public Works other than Roads and Bridges in Abruzzi Compartimento.

4. Inasmuch as the principal part of your work will lie in the Marche Compartimento and as your weekly conferences in Ancona at the present time necessitate your absence from Aquila three days per week, and contemplated surveys of the forward provinces will necessitate more time there I believe that it would be advantageous to establish your headquarters in the cities of Ascoli Piceno or Macerata more conveniently located; for contacts with the Italian official in charge of electrical surveys and rehabilitation, the heads of U.N.R.S. generating stations, Army electrical officials and as a center for your own survey and inspection trips.
