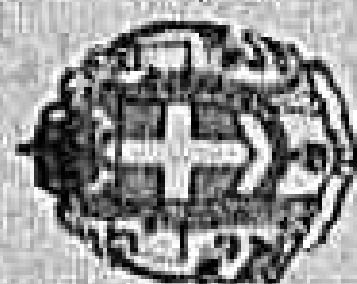

ELECTRICITY: LOW STATE OF RESERVOIRS.

Caller: A Presidential Council meeting is being held to-day in order to decide what provision should be made to meet the electricity crisis. I will take part to represent the EDISON Group. I would like to know exactly what the situation is.

Callee: Representatives of the Labour Office attended a meeting yesterday, and are convinced that the situation is not so tragic as it would seem, and would like to approach the Allied Governor with a proposal to limit the shifts to three instead of two, in order to reduce the interruption to two days.

Caller: What have the Labour Office to do with it? Are you able to increase the power?

Callee: Owing to the workers.....they are not agreeable to these reductions and say that factories must run for six days a week. Now they want to approach the Lombardy Governor, Col. HANCOCK, for a derogation of the order. This would be disastrous as the situation is difficult.

Caller: What is happening in PIEMONTE?

Callee: The Mayor of TURIN came for this reason to MILAN. The three days reduction is already in force, in spite of the fact that the PIEMONTE workers opposed. We have 500 million KWs. The ADRIATICA are not able to keep going and have already asked for help. With hopes in this condition we can only keep going till after Christmas....We consume 12 millions KWts a day. Lakes in the province of Brescia are completely gone. The OKLI are emptying their reservoirs,

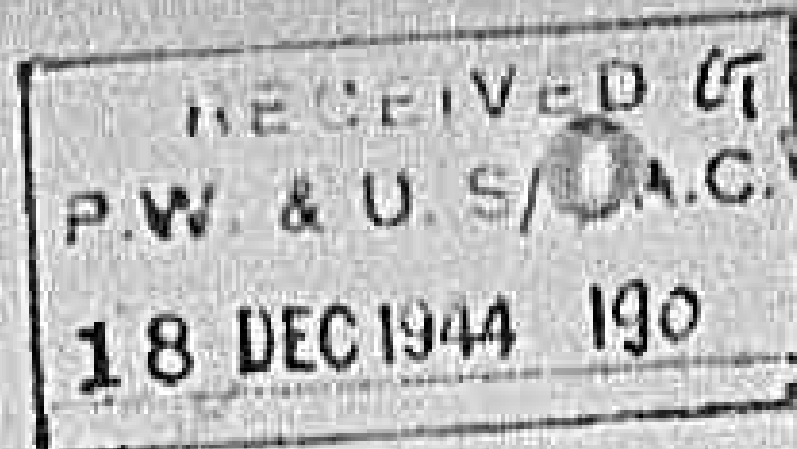
