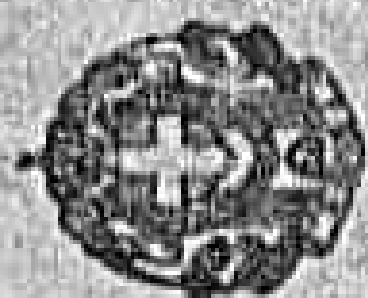

SUBJECT: Albanian Missions to Italy

TO : Headquarters, Allied Commission, APO 394

1. The Italian Consul General in Albania has informed R21, Albania that the Albanian Government desires to send three missions to Italy; the composition and purpose of these missions is as follows:

a. First mission: consisting of Messrs KOL MUQALLI and KELLEZI, and Dr. FINK - the two first named individuals are Albanians and the last-named is an Italian employee of the State Bank - to discuss financial matters and prepare the ground for economic negotiations.

b. Second mission: composition unknown but object would be "to purchase spare parts"; it is regretted that further information concerning this mission is not available.

c. Third mission: would consist of Messrs. LIL DOGA (an Albanian merchant), HAKIN RUSCA and Domenico CAVASOLA, respectively an inspector and employee of the Albanian Ministry of Public Works; object would be to purchase decorations and fittings for the New Presidential Offices in Tirana.

2. This HQ is not in favour of increasing the number of Albanian missions in Italy and it is considered that such applications should not be granted unless some really useful object is likely to be achieved.

3. In view of economic conditions at present obtaining in Italy it is not thought that the present time is at all appropriate to authorize any of the missions listed in para 1, subject as regards the third mission to the contents of para 5 of this letter, but before a reply is made to R21 Albania your comments on the proposals are requested.

4. In any event KOL MUQALLI is not considered by G-2 to be a suitable type of person to enter Italy at this juncture.

5. With regard to the third mission it should perhaps be added that Gozzander, R21 Albania has personally be approached by a representative of the Albanian Government on this subject and states that it could have a good effect on his relations with the Albanian Government if this request was granted. If furniture and fittings are in fact available for purchase in Italy it is thought that this request is not unreasonable and that this mission should be authorized to enter Italy on the express understanding that its activities are limited to the matters specified in para 1 (c).

1. In the past, considerable difficulty has been encountered in receiving replies to letters concerning the entry into Italy of individuals on a commercial basis. Normally it has required from a week to ten days to get replies from Sub-Commissions after the correspondence has left the Economic Section, as a result AC received "hurry-up" cables and recently enquiries as to why it takes so long to prepare replies.

2. As a policy, in the future, all correspondence concerning the entry of individuals into Italy are to be answered within 48 hours after receipt. It is expected that requests to enter Italy will continue to increase in volume in the next two months and to avoid unnecessary correspondence between ALCON and AFM it is requested that all correspondence be treated as URGENT.

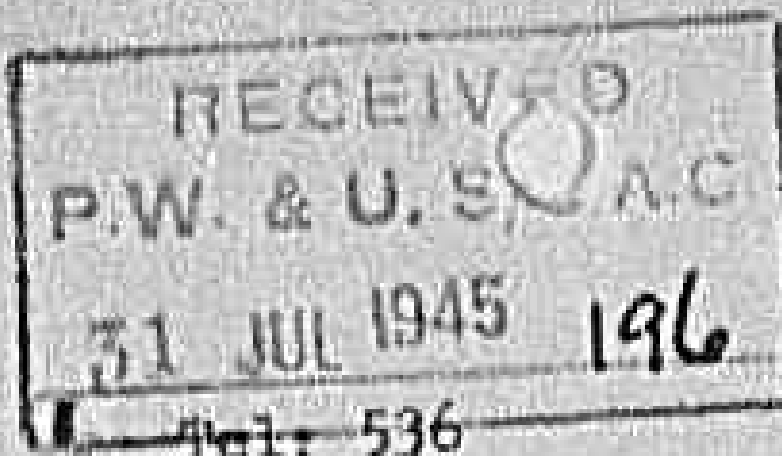

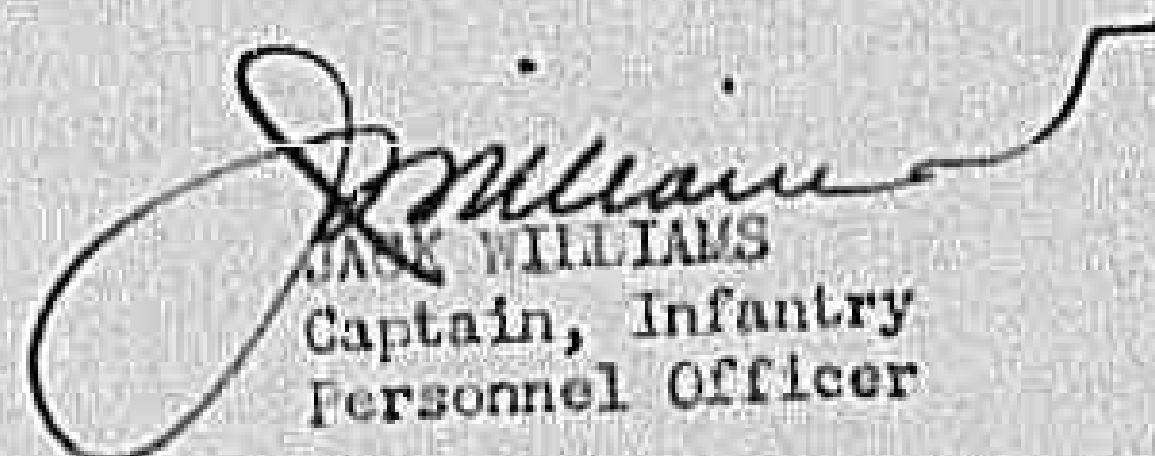

1. Reference G-5 300.4-4 7 February 1945.
2. The Public Works and Utilities Sub-Commission is interested in having Allied or neutral experts come to Italy to assist in the rehabilitation of utilities, particularly in the early stages in electric utilities.
3. We do not recommend representatives being sent to Italy on exploration trips but what we do recommend that they be permitted to enter Italy if so requested by this Sub-Commission naming persons or firms desired to be sent to Italy.
4. We further recommend that the number of persons in each case be limited to say two or not more than three persons per firm, preferably only two.
5. If these are permitted to enter, some ~~area~~ ^{arrangement} will have to be made to permit these to utilize Allied billeting and messing facilities and for that purpose they may have to be attached to the Allied Commission for the duration of their stay in Italy.

I think you may be interested to know that the Foreign Office have been in communication with the State Department in Washington with a view to a suggestion being submitted to the Supreme Allied Commander that he should consider issuing a directive with regard to visits of representatives of private commercial interests to Italy.

The line which the Foreign Office have taken is that in general, there should be as soon as possible a relaxation of the present restriction of entry but that this relaxation should be gradual, so as to avert an influx, which might be unwelcome to Supreme Allied Commander.

The Foreign Office suggestion is, broadly, that no-one should be allowed to visit Italy for the purpose of prospecting for new business but that owners and managers of established firms only, whether Allied or neutral, should be allowed to come provided their visits are a necessary preliminary to the resumption of business. Representatives of banks and insurance companies should also be permitted to enter for the purpose of finding out the facts, but the starting of their business would depend entirely on the general Italian financial situation.

As to trade in general, the Foreign Office are of the opinion that it should always be subject to the general control of Allied Commission acting under instructions for Chief of Staff and, in the case of reserved items, to the assent of the Combined Boards. There would probably have to be special regulations for neutral countries but in any case any imports to supply Italy with her essential needs would have to be reported to United Kingdom and United States Governments.

1. This is in reference and precisation of our letter 73 of November 6 1944 in which we request the permission for specialists to make certain field inspections to land reclamation works in the Toscana Province.

2°. The Associazione will not make inspections in order to gather information similar or related to those in possession of Italian competent Ministries. The Associazione has the aim to enter in possession of elements and data relating to the situation and possibility of execution of public works by Bonifica Consortia. As known, according to Italian law the Consortia will be the boards charged with the duty to make public works; and because the Associazione is the Board of the Consortia it must have the possibility to have the elements and data necessary for technical assistance and specially for financial one. In effect the Consortia have to face a period in which the works are to be made and the State does not pay until works are ended (problem of provisory financing)

3°. As regards the size of the group proposed it is suggested that there will be many travels and inquiries; so it is necessary to have the possibility to send one or another of the specialists according to the necessities and local exigences.

We hope that you will kindly examine the matter again.

Italian competent Ministries (Agriculture and Public Works) have been informed of the enquiry above mentioned.

My dear Mr. Prime Minister,

Recent incident arising out of the visits of certain Ministers of the Italian Government to areas in liberated Italy still in the military operational zone, that is to say, in the Army areas, have led General Alexander to the conclusion that it is undesirable that such visits should be repeated.

I do not deny the value, both to the population and the Ministers themselves, of such visits but my duty is to ensure that nothing should occur in these operational zones which may cause anxiety to the Military Commanders, a duty which I am sure you will help me to perform.

I would ask you, therefore, to note that only in the most exceptional cases can permission be granted to Ministers of the Government to visit such operational areas.

There will be no objection to Ministers and Undersecretaries of State visiting territories under the administration of AMG South of the Army areas. In such cases permissions should be sought from this Headquarters and Ministers and officials should visit the Provincial Commissioner or the nearest Provincial Officer in the area which they are visiting.
