1. It is confirmed that the Shovel (Bucyrus Erie with Crane Attachment) which you kindly loaned to this Area is still urgently required for Military purposes. The project is complete reconditioning of runway at Ciampino Airfield. As far as can be foreseen the Crane will be free to be returned to you on 5 September 1945. If possible it will be returned before that date.

2. If it is practicable to loan us a second Crane of similar capacity for the same period we should be most grateful.

3. As arranged on 11 August 1945, this letter is being delivered by 1st Lieutenant W. G. Davis, CE, on 13 August 1945.

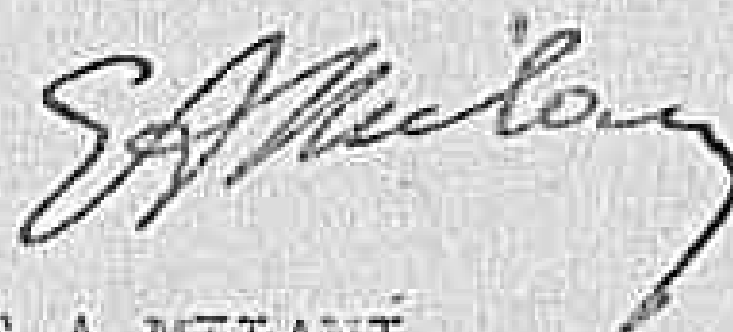

1. Reference is made to possibility of securing certain equipment, vouchered to the Italian Government, controlled by the Allied Commission for use in Emilia Region.

2. We have had the U.S.V.S. engineer make a study of the situation and attached in duplicate is tabulated data requesting assignment of -

- 6 Power shovels
- 24 Bitumen heaters
- 24 Bitumen spi sprayers
- 7 Road graders (power driven)
- 6 Rock crushers (with power)

3. No road rollers are listed, but it is felt that if any are available at least 6 should be added to the request.

4. Information is also requested as to availability jack former cutters and power driven air compressors and earth moving equipment. There should have at least 6 of each.

5. Your consideration of our needs will be appreciated, as we are in need of more than ordinary help due to the fact that this territory have the brunt of the winter fighting and materials and equipment are very scarce. Lack of trucks is a serious matter.

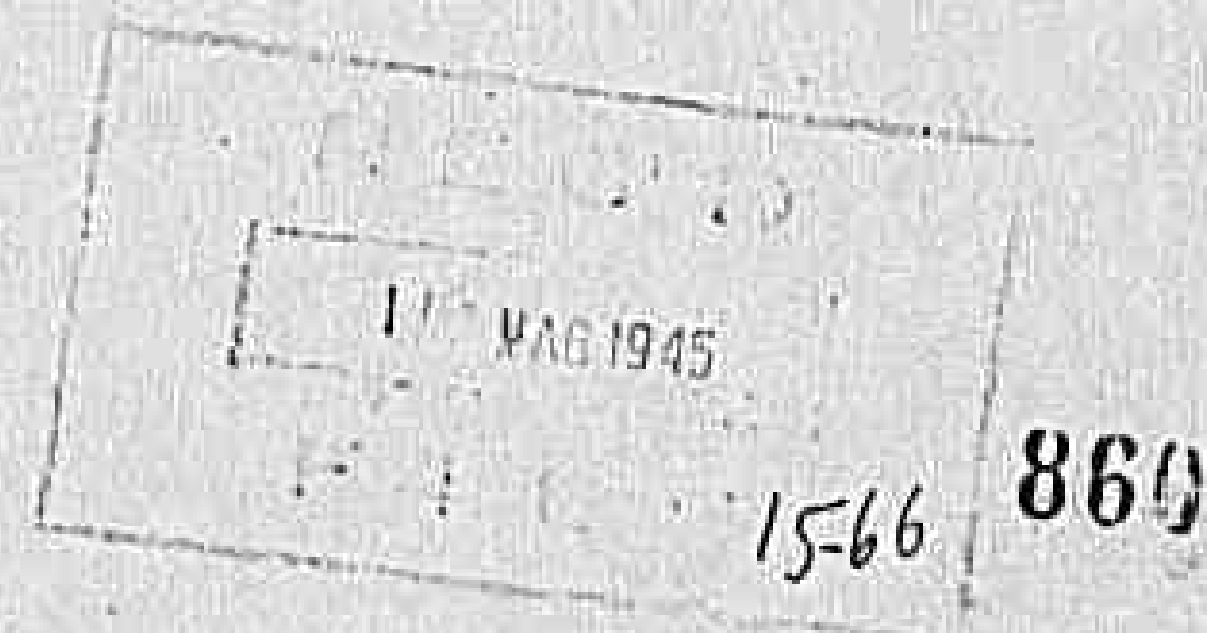
