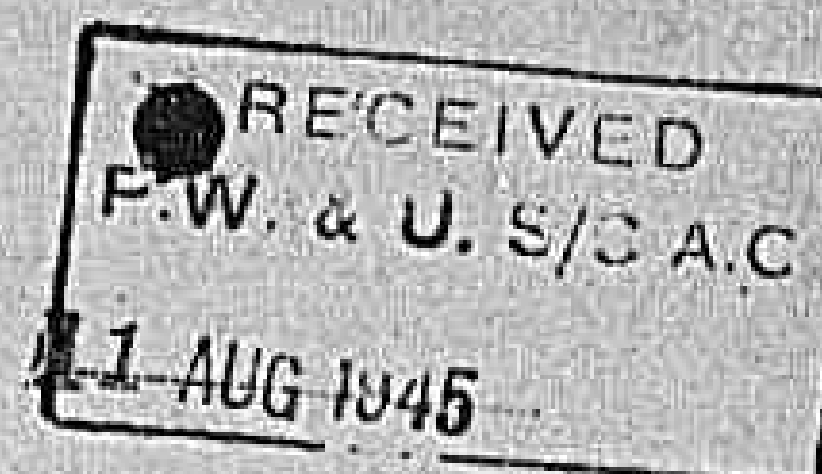

Subject: Application for Telephone Service.

To: See Distribution.

1. Telephone service in Rome is supplied under two separate classifications:

- a. Military.
- b. Civilian.

2. Applications for Military Telephone Service in Rome Area will be submitted to the Signal Officer, RAAG, by unit Signal officers or a commissioned representative, and will show complete information on the following points (for officer billet telephone, see par 4):

- a. Number of lines required (minimum).
- b. Name of Section or Headquarters.
- c. Directory information of officers to be served.
- d. What, if any, civil lines now in place?
- e. Exact and accurate location by address and map coordinates.
- f. Whom to contact for further information.

3. Applications for telephone service for civilians.

a. It is recognized that in many cases civilians of all nationalities in Rome Area perform essential duties for the Allied Forces. Normally civilian outgoing telephone service is rationed: 4 outgoing calls per day for single line, 2 outgoing calls per day for Duplex or party line. Essential subscribers may obtain increase calling rate of 8 or 12, or unlimited calls per day when need is established by local or military authority.

2. Applications for Military Telephone Service in Rome Area will be submitted to the Signal Officer, RAAC, by unit Signal officers or a commissioned representative, and will show complete information on the following points (for officer billet telephone, see par 4):

- a. Number of lines required (minimum).
- b. Name of Section or Headquarters.
- c. Directory information of officers to be served.
- d. What, if any, civil lines now in place?
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b. In all cases where a commissioned officer can vouch for the necessity of telephone service for civilians, these requests will be considered by this office.

c. The following procedure will govern:

(1) For civilian office and duty telephones, commissioned officer, certifying the need for telephone service, will submit in writing the following information to the Signal Officer, RAAC.

- a. Full name of civilian.
- b. Directory listing for telephone requested.
- c. Exact address of the telephone.
- d. Telephone number of instrument in place, if any.

(3) For civilian telephone service not essential to the military, requests are submitted by the civilian, direct to TETI, 208 Corso Vittorio Emanuele, Rome. Statements from members of the Allied Forces in this respect are meaningless.

4. Additional information on Real Estate requisitions:

a. Requisitions on billets do not include telephone service.

b. To obtain military priority for billet telephones (unlimited calls and the responsibility of the accounts), a definite need must be established for:

(1) General Officers.

(2) Chief of Sections.

(3) Key personnel requiring 24 hour contact (calling).

c. The following information will be furnished to the Signal Officer, RAAC, for billet telephone service:

(1) Directory Service Information

(2) What telephone number, if any, is now operating?

(3) Whom to contact for further information and where?

(a) All the machines listed above and transferred to this Headquarters were stripped of tools, accessories, drills, cables, electrodes, drive belts and all other fixtures of a removable nature, by Meccano Elettrica and removed to their new premises. This makes inoperable all the equipment transferred to this Headquarters.

(b) All motors were removed from the machines they powered. Motor, Savigliano, No. 449407, 2.5 H.P., and Motor, AEG, No. 19561, 2.0 H.P., were substituted with other motors and removed from the Contin factory.
