Allied Military forces have been maintaining main and subsidiary highways throughout Italy in order to keep the highways in condition to carry military and essential civilian traffic.

AFHQ have advised that it is imperative that military services units be relieved of this function as soon as practicable and have also stated that it is essential that highway maintenance be not permitted to fall below a level sufficient to support British and U.S. redeployment.

It is also necessary that withdrawal of military maintenance unit will not interrupt the internal distribution of essential civilian supplies. Much of the automotive stock available for movement of civil supplies is in poor condition and failure to maintain the road network in reasonable condition will result in rapidly increasing rate of deterioration which will further jeopardize the movement of essential civilian supplies.

Ruined railways and lack of adequate deep water ports have placed great reliance on the highway system which itself has been badly worn and damaged.

With the termination of military responsibility for civilian supply it is desired that the Italian Government assume full responsibility for highway maintenance, and thus for internal civilian supply distribution which is dependent on the highway system. This can only be accomplished by transfer of the necessary equipment to the Italian Government.

(Reqn. MGS-180-ENG/LAC Airgram 35)TO : Headquarters, Allied Commission, APO 394
(Attn. Economic Section)

1. Your RB-400/168 of 2 July has been received in reply to our H-2 of 19 June.
2. The information requested in para. 6 of our letter referred above regarding equipment ex Persian Gulf on the BARON CANDOR should be sent to this Section as soon as it has been possible to carry out an accurate check of equipment unloaded. As also should information regarding the 100 tons of Highway Equipment ex Persian Gulf now being unloaded at Bari from the AVRISTAN - the 2 Boxes Rotary Sweepers (1 ton) aboard the SEA ADDER (BA 254) which was due at NAPLES for GENOA period 25 June - 4 July - and other subsequent shipments.
3. Further, as difficulty is being experienced here in striking a balance between the status of MGS-180-ENG. according to our records (Appdx. "A" to our H-2 of 19 June refers) and the statement of equipment delivered by items and pieces from the various sources as reflected by you in the list attached to your RB-400/168 of 2 July, it is requested that you compare the two summaries and advise whether you can clarify regarding the following points:
 - a. Items 12 & 13 (GRADERS) are referred against which you show 44 units received against only 30 requisitioned. We do not have a copy of the TN ref quoted in your list but it is thought that the LESLIE SHAW carried Barley from Iraq and that the J.J. PETTIGREW, BA 104 in UGS 80 carried 214 tons Primary & Secondary Units. It is not known whether "Primary & Secondary Units" are definitely Graders, but if so mention should have been made. Neither was mention made by you of 50 tons Graders on the J. FRANK COOPER, UGS-80, BA 203.
 - b. Item 21 is referred against which you show 3 units as received - presumably these are the 3 due from the U.S. Did you not also receive 1 unit ex U.S. theatre stocks? This was made available to you by Engineer Shipping Document MTO-ENG-IV-4744, Consignor CG 1239, Consignee ESO PBS (Southern District), to be released to you upon arrival at Naples - our H-2 of 2
