SUBJECT : Devastated Areas Committee Meeting.

1. At the meeting of the above named Committee held on 29th November 1944 it was agreed that, in order to assist the reconstruction in the devastated areas, it would be necessary to provide such items as glass, cement, bricks, roofing-tiles etc. The matter of having plants re-established in this Region to manufacture these basic commodities was to be referred to the Industry Sub-Commission for action.

2. This is a matter which I have brought up on many previous meetings of the Economic Section, but apparently without result. We are deeply interested in this matter and I believe it necessary for you to follow this matter with the Industry Sub-Commission and keep me advised of the progress made.
