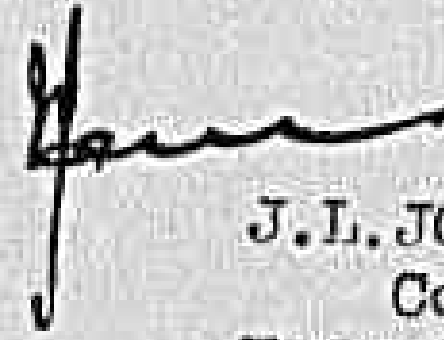

Sir;

I have the honour to submit for your consideration a request to be retained in my present post as Regional Public Works Officer, Lombardia.

My name was submitted by Public Works and Utilities Sub-Commission for Military Government Austria at a time when it was thought that Military Government Austria would be almost completely British and that there would be opportunities for advancement.

With the recent change in policy which will divide Austria into four zones of occupation, and the consequent shrinkage of appointments on the British side, I consider that my services could be put to better use in Northern Italy.

The following are my reasons for saying so:

- (a) The appointment of Regional Public Works Officer for Lombardia Region, which has a population of about 6,000,000, is a much bigger job than that of Engineer in an Austrian Gau with a population of about 1,000,000.
- (b) Before entering Civil Affairs I had three years experience with Royal Engineers Works Services. This enabled me to discuss with R.E. officers of British Districts and Areas all works problem in relation to Civil Affairs. I myself have held the appointment of D.C.R.E. I also worked in close contact with C.E. No. 1 District when I was Regional Public Works Officer, Sicily.
- (c) I have had longer experience of Public Works Administration with AMG/AC Italy than any other officer in A.C.
- (d) Col. Bolick and I worked together in Sicily for nine months. I have been working with him on instructions and plans for Lombardia for seven weeks.

This application is forwarded with the sole intention of bringing to your notice the fact that instead of being given a job of greater responsibility, I have been selected to fill a minor post which could probably be filled by a junior officer instead of using a Major in his fourth year of seniority.
