REPORT OF INSPECTION OF SALVAGE SCRAP MATERIALS AT P.B.S. DUMPS IN LEGHORN AREA.

INSPECTION CARRIED OUT ON JANUARY 21st and 22nd.

SECTION "A" TEXTILES AND MISCELLANEOUS SCRAP.

COTTON RAGS. None available - sent out to various American Units - demand exceeds supply.

SHELTER HALF SCRAP. Small pieces of American "Bivy" tents.

SCRAP HEAVY LEATHER. Mostly harness leathers. Italian pack mule harness.

LISTER BAG SCRAP. American water containers in very poor condition, only useful for scrap.

SCRAP RAIN-COATS. Mackintosh in very poor condition. They are tied up in bales and in many cases are in small pieces. A portion might be useful for welfare purposes.

SCRAP WEBBING. All American - canvas ammunition pouches etc.

SCRAP PROTECTIVE COVERS. A/gas American. Some of this appeared to be in good condition.

SCRAP CAMOUFLAGE NETS. Very old - useful to break down into thread.

SCRAP RUBBER AND CANVAS HOSE. Some of this is in lengths up to 12ft. Rubber perished.

PAPER. Old proclamations, etc.

CARDBOARD. Some of this is heavy waxed cardboard.

CARDBOARD AMMO: CONTAINERS. Fair condition.

SECTION "B" The heavy Ferrous, light Ferrous and Aluminium Scrap are all situated in one dump on the Pisa Road.

Before any Material is placed in this Dump it has gone through an Ordinance dump and is examined by experts. Nothing is released to the P.B.S. Scrap dump which has any mechanical value.

The P.B.S. have contacted an Italian firm in Leghorn who will deal with this scrap. This firm has the necessary equipment and furnaces to carry out the job.

SECTION "B"

They are highly reputable and well known to P.B.S. If the dump was sold 'en bloc' it would be immediately closed and the Light Ferreous and Aluminium Scrap would be dealt with at once.

The Heavy Ferreous is very difficult to handle owing to the shortage of acetylene gas and would probably in many cases be left in its present position until after the war.

- 1) The Tanks, wheel bogies, gun barrels, are only good for smelting.
- 2) The Chassis, Springs and assemblies have all been examined by experts and condemned as useless. The chassis and Springs have in many cases been burnt. It might be possible by breaking the assemblies down further to obtain small parts.

SECTION "C"

Some of the bodies could possibly be put to use.

SECTION "D"

CRASHED AND burnt out planes - all have been thoroughly examined for parts.

With regard to Para 3 of P.B.S. letter dated 8th January the following items have begun to accumulate again:-

Rubber and Leather shoe findings.
Canvas cot cover scrap.
Scrap rubber and canvas overshoes.
Assorted small bottles.
