1. Attached are copies of correspondence from representative of the above named Commission.
2. It appears that the Provincial Commission is organized in such a manner as to inable it, in the early stages to operate as an advisory body, and later when fully acquainted with the tasks, to receive and exercise such authority as RAC may delegate.
3. The Commission is appointed by the Prefect under Royal Decree No 95 of 3 April 1944 and has jurisdiction only in the province of Rome.
4. The members are representatives of other provincial administrative and technical organizations whose activities are related to the distribution and consumption of electric energy, namely, the Prefecture, the Civil Engineers, the Chamber of Commerce, Industry, and Agriculture, the Electricity Companies, and the Industrial Companies.
5. A permanent technical and clerical staff is to be appointed as indicated in attached notes.
6. Full records will be kept and the Commission will be in a position to deal with applications for power, pursue investigations, enforce regulations for power, of civil police, and to render any advice or recommendations that may be called for.
7. It is suggested that RAC recommend

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5. A permanent technical and clerical staff is to be appointed as indicated in attached notes.

7. It is suggested that RAC recognise the Commission and, in order to develop it into a responsible organization, use it as a channel for communication with the Power Companies.
8. The full time staff will be able to deal with immediate communication by telephone and will if it is required maintain an employee in the Engineer Services

ORGANIZATION OF EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF THE COMMITTEE FOR ELECTRIC
POWER DISTRIBUTION IN ROME AREA.

The Office will be composed by one Secretariat and three Sections.
Secretariat:

This branch will handle secretarial work of Committee, the managing of the office, carrying out of duty N°9 and recordings according to the plan established with Engineering Division. One administrative employee and one clerk will be attached to the Secretariat. Eng. Salvadori will be in charge of the Secretariat.

1st Section:

This branch will handle distribution of power and statistics, specifically duties N°2.3.4.5.8b according to the plan established with Engineering Division. One technical employee and one clerk will be attached to this Section. Eng. Ungaro will be in charge of 1st Section.

2nd Section:

This branch will handle filing of applications, power allocations and revision of consumers, specifically duties N° 3.5a.5b.7 and recordings regarding connections according to the plan established with Engineering Division. One technical employee of the Distribution Companies and two clerks will be attached to the 2nd Section. Eng. Razzano will be in charge of this Section.

3rd Section:

This branch will handle the checking and enforcements as per plan established with Engineering Division. One technical employee of the Distribution Companies and one clerk will be attached to the 3rd Section. One of the Managing Offices will supply a technical employee who will be in charge of 3rd Section. Eng. Ungaro will coordinate the work of the three 3rd Section fulfilling duty N°6 as per plan agreed with Engineering Division. He will regularly report to the Committee about work planned and carried out by the Office.

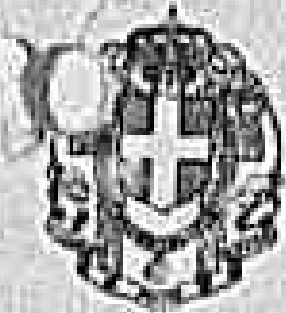

PLAN OF ACTION BY THE COMMITTEE FOR THE CONTROL OF ELECTRIC
POWER DISTRIBUTION IN ROME AREA ACCORDING TO REQUESTS ADDRESSED
TO THE PRESIDENT DR. SCAMBELLURI.

(Forwarded to this Office by Eng. Ungaro)

TRANSLATION

1. The Committee will dispose that the Military Preferential circuits should have first priority and be therefore the last to be disconnected and only in case of absolute necessity, in establishing priority order for disconnecting circuits when necessity arises of a reduction of load (this priority order will be submitted to the approval of the Allied Authorities).
2. The Committee will revise all preferential civilian and arrange the proper switchings on the cables in order to disconnect the parasites. This would result in a considerable reduction of load on preferential cables.
3. Special technical staff and civil Policemen will be entrusted with the control of preferential and normal users. Special investigation will be committed to the Civil Policemen for the purpose of supervising the consumers and the Power Companies staff, whenever the suspicion of abuse or fraud arises. It is hoped that this will reduce soon abusive connections and stealing of power.
4. All the applications for power excepting the normal ones for lighting must be sent to the Distribution Companies who will give their opinion about the technical possibility of their supply. The requests will be forwarded to the Committee who, after a careful selection, will approve only the most necessary and urgent ones. In case of approval the Committee will fix for each consumer the amount of energy and the hours in which the supply will be allowed.
5. Allied Military Authorities will be contacted both through office channels and a suitable person who will inform and notify the Committee of the wishes of above mentioned Authorities.

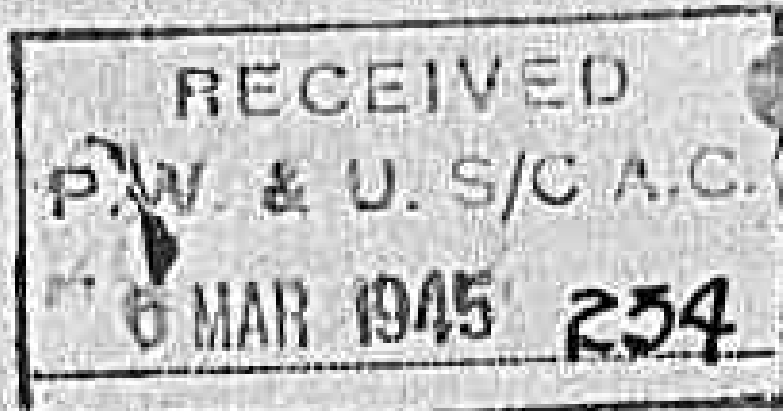

2. Copies of proposed organization for commission distributed which have been agreed on by Engineering Division in conjunction with two representatives of Committee.

3. Regional Engineer opened by saying that the meeting had been called to formally approve the contents of the proposal. He asked first if all present were in agreement on every point (yes) and secondly if it was within the limits of the decree. This was unanimously agreed.

4. Regional Engineer stated that the proposals made by this Committee would be sent to the Prefect through Provincial Commissioner.

5. Prefect's representative wished that a representative of the Engineering Division should be attached to the commission and that "vice versa" a liaison engineer from the commission should be attached to the Engineering Division.

6. Regional Engineer confirmed that complete control of electricity distribution at present rests with RAC. He has, however, obtained the verbal accord of RAC (Major Hughes) and CRL 104 (Lt. Col. Cockerton). Before they can transfer any responsibility they must have the sanction of the Commanding General.

7. Regional Engineer continued by saying that the degree of responsibility given to the commission would depend upon the manner in which they dealt the problems that would arise.

Prefect's representative assured the Committee that they would do all in their ability, but that he anticipated many difficulties at first.

Regional Engineer appreciated this and wished for close collaboration during the first months.

8. Regional Engineer read extract from his letter to Provincial Commissioner proposing that the Prefect should employ a full-time staff for the Commission. This point was approved.

9. The question ~~for~~ of premises for the commission then arose but the Regional Engineer ruled that it was a matter for the Prefect to make a decision on.

SUGGESTED ORGANIZATION FOR PROVINCIAL COMMISSION

COMPOSITION

- 1) Councillor of Prefecture - President.
- 2) Technical Officer of the Genio Civile.
- 3) Representative of the Provincial Council of Economy.

FUNCTIONS

1. To receive the allotments of energy from the Military Authorities after all military requirements have been met and provide for the repartition of the remaining power available.
2. Supervision of the various consumers and modification of the rationing plans with regard to the load diagrams for power and energy allocated.
3. Allocation of energy to consumers who will make requests through the Distribution Companies. The Companies will forward these demands to the Commission expressing their opinion on the technical possibilities of supply.
4. To adjust periodically the rationing plans for civilian users in accordance with the availability.
5.
 - a) Periodical revision of the order of precedence of civil users and consequent proposals to the competent Authorities.
 - b) Periodical revision of the circuit priorities with a view to disconnection in case of overload. Approval to be obtained from the competent Authorities.
6. To make agreement with the Distribution Companies ensuring that the instructions of the Commission are carried out.
7. Estimation of the loads of the various consumers, already

9. Adoption of systems of propaganda to obtain the best use of the energy, the greatest cooperation on the part of the users and the elimination of abuses and of stealing of energy.

RECORDS

To keep records both of approved applications and of refused applications for connections, and all other records necessary for the efficient functioning of the Commission. These records will be held available at all times for inspection by Military Authorities. Such periodical reports as may be required by them will be forwarded.

CONTROLS

1. Control to insure that the various categories receive the energy allocated to them under the scale of priorities.
2. Control of the use and consumption on the part of the industrial consumers.
3. Controls to prevent the stealing of energy to be carried out by the Distribution Companies.
4. Verifying that the consumers wrongfully connected are discovered by the Distribution Companies.

Means to carry out the controls and the surveyance

Controls and verifications will be effected by the competent Authorities; and by the Distribution Companies according to the instructions and under the control of the Commission.

ENFORCEMENTS

Nature of the Enforcements against fraud and abuses.
The enforcements appropriate for eliminating abuses and frauds will be issued on the authority of the Prefect and will consist in the application of monetary sanctions or in the temporary or permanent disconnection.

1. Your attention is called to Royal Decree No. 95 of 3rd April 1944 published in the Official Gazette No. 17 of 5th April 1944.

Will you please invite the Prefect to appoint immediately the Commission as per art. 8 and prepare to assume responsibility for the enactment of the various provisions laid down therein, together with any Proclamations issued or which may be issued.

2. Attached is a memorandum on suggested organization for the Provincial Commission which summarizes the most urgent functions that it should fulfill, and states the main points for coordination with the military authorities.

This was drawn up in conference with the representatives of your office, Industry Division, and Italian authorities concerned. Copy of minutes of final conference attached.

3. Please also request the Prefect to provide the Commission with the necessary full-time staff to fulfill the duties which are onerous.

4. The "Competent Authorities" mentioned in para. 5 is the Central Committee set up under art. 8 of the decree.

At present, however, while control of electricity is held by military authorities and allocations are made to military districts and by them through AC/ENG channels to civilian consumers as laid down in AAI/3064/A(o) dated 8 August 1944 the powers given to the Commission under the decree must be governed by such instructions as are issued by the military authorities and transmitted to the Commission through AC/ENG channels.

5. The present normal consumption is too near the peak production and results in reduced voltage and overloads necessitating frequent disconnections of blocks of consumers

without warning.

It is therefore important to get the Commission functioning quickly.

6. As direct control has been in the past exercised by military districts ~~through~~ ^{by} Regional Engineer and power Companies I shall be pleased to assist the Commission in the initial steps with information at our disposal and will welcome the closest cooperation.
