2. The War Materials Sub-Commission has informed us that none of the tools listed are available as salvage at this time. However, they have a list of captured enemy engineering stores which they obtained through Public Works Sub-Commission on behalf of the Ministry of Public Works. This list contains a number of picks, shovels, axes, saws and sledge hammers. They have no knowledge as yet of the date the material will be available for transfer, but they will keep your needs in mind.

Fano having been in Alto Adige it appears that in sundry collecting warehouses or left along the roads there are electrical materials such as transformers, switches, joints and so on, which could be extremely useful for the restoration of our Company's electrical plants, and which at present lie useless and risking to be damaged or lost.
- 2) We therefore beg you warmly to interest yourself in the possibility of obtaining a/m materials to be allotted to us, to be made use of till an eventual proprietor may claim them.
- 3) Believing this solution to be made according to the general interest as well as in the interest of the eventual proprietor, and such as to be seriously considered, we are sure you will also take an interest in the matter.
- 4) In the same warehouse there are also many tyres for Italian motor cars lying idle, which all finish by and by into the local black market.
- 5) You are aware in which conditions we have to fight, in order to keep into efficiency our motor vehicles, while these tyres would be extremely useful for us.
- 6) We therefore beg you to see if it were possible to obtain from competent authorities the blockade raising on our behalf for a certain number of a/m tyres.

SUBJECT: Captured Enemy Vehicles

TO : Regional Engineer Piemonte

1. Ref. your PR/ENG/100.12/31 July 1945.

2. It is regretted that the entire number of vehicles released to you were not in running condition when called for, but it is believed that any arrangements to obtain such vehicles, will necessarily have to be made between your officer and the officers at the impounding pool as the vehicles are being removed as rapidly as they can be taken out. It is believed that in many cases it would pay to tow the vehicles to a nearby shop at Brescia and have the repairs made, rather than to take an inferior vehicle that is in running condition later, as in most cases the defect is a minor one.

3. It is quite impossible for this headquarters to assure availability of any vehicles being handled by another section as they are released on the basis of "first come first served". It is suggested that you send an officer with the necessary drivers to take whatever time is necessary to secure the vehicles and have minor repairs made at the O.M. shop in Brescia. Lt. Hartmann will be glad to assist in securing preferential treatment for your vehicles at the O.M. plant, but unfortunately we do not have a sufficient number of officers to assist you further.

SUBJECT: Captured Enemy Vehicles

TO : C G Fifth Army
att. G 5 (Major D.M. Gaither, Engineer Officer)

1. Reference is made to your letter 20 July, file 205/4, subject "Release of CE Vehicles" and to your wire F 292 on same subject.

2. On 28 July an officer from this HQ (Major Robb) went to Ghedi to pick up the vehicles. He was informed that five trucks were in running condition and that ten would have to be towed. The four passenger cars were loaded on four trucks. On examination, however, only two trucks were found to be in running condition.

3. It appeared to be definitely unwise to attempt to tow vehicles of questionable value some 275 kilometers and only the two trucks (each carrying a sedan) were taken. The personnel in charge of the impounded vehicle pool stated that vehicles which would run would be made available this week.

4. Your attention is called to the fact that a full day's time of an officer was required for this abortive trip. It now is necessary to devote another day to another trip. It therefore is requested that you make an effort to assure availability of trucks which will be in condition to use on MSR as originally contemplated in your letter cited above.
