Reference your No. 3555 dated 17/5/45 addressed to our Rome Office, the following is the situation of the machinery as per above quoted contracts, which, owing to war action, is remained with our Company.

Firstly we inform you that, when the communications with Rome have been cut during June 1944, we have immediately taken any action required for protecting your machinery from air raids or any other damage or loss consequent to war actions.

As for the 3,000 KW turbine, we have to inform you that the German authorities, who were aware of its existence, have ordered its requisition on behalf of the S.A. Carbonifera ARSA of Trieste.

We understand that the unit has not yet been installed in the Arsa Thermal Generating Plant for which it was intended.

Reference your 4603 dated 26 June 1945, we beg to confirm what has been verbally stated by our Eng. Sacco to your Dr. Eng. Parvopasso re situation of machinery at present moment.

Namely, the turbine-alternator unit is at present at Arsia in the Mines of ARSA Società Carbonifera, that is in an area the destination of which is still to be decided. The unit is not being utilized.

The Società Carbonifera Arsa ordered said unit only as a spare in fear of eventual destructions to the plants, and therefore, as this did not happen, the unit appears to be surplus for them.

We confirm that the only line to follow would be to take this matter up with the Allied Command, representing your needs and the fact that the unit is not needed by the Carbonifera Arsa, in view of obtaining its restitution.

We add that we had suspended our work after 8 September 43 in order to prevent requisition of the machine, but in the last months of 1944 the German Occupation Authorities compelled us to deliver the unit to the a/m Company. We had to complete ~~work~~ ~~the~~ said machine by working overtime under continuous supervision of the German Headquarters.

The Machinery was completed and shipped to the new address in March 1944, and we were requested to send our fitters for assembling the machine. We opposed several pretexts until the insurrection of last April made ourselves free from all engagements.

We have tried to get a/m unit back, but our action has been

unsuccessful.

Reference your 4603 dated 26 June 1945, we beg to confirm what has been verbally stated by our Eng. Sacco to your Dr. Eng. Parvopasso re situation of machinery at present moment.

In your and our interest, we beg you to take appropriate action for recovering the unit - which has not been ~~paid~~ to us - and we remain awaiting for your kind informations.

1. A 3,000 KW, 3,000 R.P.M., 569 psi (40 at) turbine-alternator unit is going to be supplied by Tosi Company at Legnano and Marelli Company at Milan to our Azienda Comunale Elettricità ed Acque for Montemartini Thermal Plant in Rome.
2. This modern installed in place of another obsolete 170 psi (12 at) unit for the purpose of obtaining a saving of fuel estimated at 50%.
3. The turbine had been completed by Tosi Company since the summer of 1943 but it was not delivered owing to transport difficulties. In January 1945 the German authorities ordered that the turbine be requisitioned and assigned to Società Carbonifera dell'Arsa at Trieste. The turbine was collected by the latter Co. and moved to the Arsia Thermal Plant (Istria)
4. The same German authorities compelled Marelli Company to complete the alternator and deliver it to Società Carbonifera dell'Arsa.
5. The complete unit, disassembled, is now located at the Arsia Mines where it cannot be utilized because the machinery in operation there did not suffer the destruction in anticipation of which the unit had been moved there
6. The A.C.E.A. needs the a/m unit which was illegally diverted by the German authorities.
7. As the unit is now located in an area at present not under Italian Govt. administration, the matter is deferred to the Allied Commission for appropriate action.
8. Enclosed herewith copies of letters dated 9 June and 21 September 1945 by which Tosi and Marelli Company informed ACEA of the situation.
9. The foregoing, which had already brought to your attention is now respectfully resubmitted in view of the necessity that the Montemartini Plant may be completed at earliest.

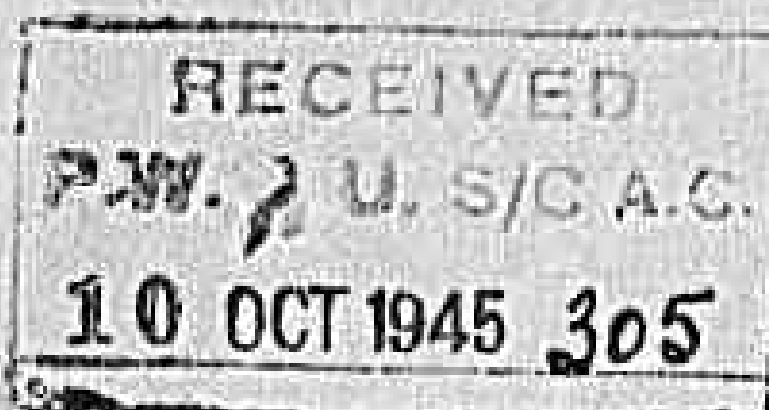

La recente piena ha rimosso queste ostruzioni, rendendo così possibile l'immissione dell'intera portata del fiume nell'alveo di magra e quindi l'ispezione nell'interno della galleria di derivazione.

Si è potuto constatare che la platea del canale presenta per un tratto di circa 3 Km. delle profonde erosioni, tali da rendere necessaria la ricostruzione dell'arco rovescio per il corrispondente tratto.

Necessita quindi l'urgente assegnazione da parte di codesta Commissione di q.li.2.000 (duemila) di cemento tipo 500; questo quantitativo non deve essere considerato compreso nelle precedenti richieste.

Dato il carattere di assoluta urgenza di questo lavoro, per far fronte alle prime necessità, si è stabilito di inviare a Mandela il quantitativo di cemento (facente parte della prima assegnazione di q.li. 1.540) che si era previsto di dover inviare a Rieti per i lavori di ri-

costruzione del ponte canale sul fiume Salto.

We have received the two lots of 24 brushes for three-phase motors with collector delivered to us on Saturday Oct. 28th in connection with our order of October 7th through the Manager of your Factory, and we have at once tried them: from the results of the first 24 hours of trial we can deduce what follows.

- 1) One has far better results as to hardness and composition of the coal with the model No. 1 brushes than with the TEI ones; these latter wear out rapidly and emit a great quantity of sparks, while the action and make-up of the No. 1 brushes seems far better.
- 2) The defect relating to the lugs which break easily at the point already pointed out in our previous letter persists. It is necessary that these lugs should be of a solid stronger pattern.
3. The defect of the insulating strips which get unstuck as soon as they get heated in use, still persists; it is necessary that these insulating strips should be kept in place by dovetailing.

We wait to be told the date of delivery of the following lots of brushes in question, up to the 1.000 that ever ordered.
