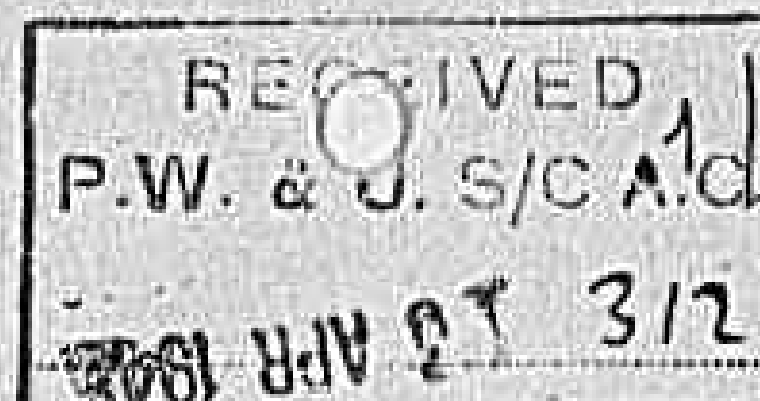

Subject:- Cement.-

Attached please find copy of letters sent to Regional Public Works Officer, Sicilia Region, regarding Italcementi of Messina.

In March 44, 1870 quintals of cement were supplied to ACC Catania through Lieut.VOS. As, when the claim was brought up, Lt.VOS was no longer with ACC and as there was no record in his files, the Firm was able to find directly the consignees and ask them for the payment. However, there remains a balance of quintals 84.50, the disposal of which could not be traced. The Firm asks the payment of Lit.27.396,50, as cost of the above quantity of cement and sacks.

Instructions were requested on 12 Sept.44 and on 18 Jan 45 to Public Works Officer, Sicily Region H.Q., but no answer has been received up to date.

It is pointed out that the Firm has got several original receipts signed by a certain Cpl.S.G.MOON, by a certain L/Cpl. whose name is illegible, but whose Army No. is T/I2I297, and by another person who is supposed to be an Officer.

Your views on this subject will be appreciated.

The attached letter from Italcementi of Messina regarding cement supplied through Lieut. VOS, A.C.C, Catania in March last, is self-explanatory. It will be noted that of the 1870 quintals supplied it has been possible to trace the disposal of 1785.50 quintals, payment for which Italcementi will claim from receivers as listed in the letter. There remains a balance of 84.50 quintals, the disposal of which cannot be traced, and the Company are claiming refund of the value of this quantity of cement and cost of sacks, a total of Lire 27396.50.

When this claim was first brought up (see attached copy of letter dated 1 Jul 44 from Italcementi and enclosure) Lt. VOS was no longer with ACC and a search through his files did not lead to any satisfactory result. It was only after considerable trouble that some of the consignees could be traced. As Lt. VOS kept no record of the chits he issued to both the Military and Civilian Consignees, it is impossible at this late stage to search any further.

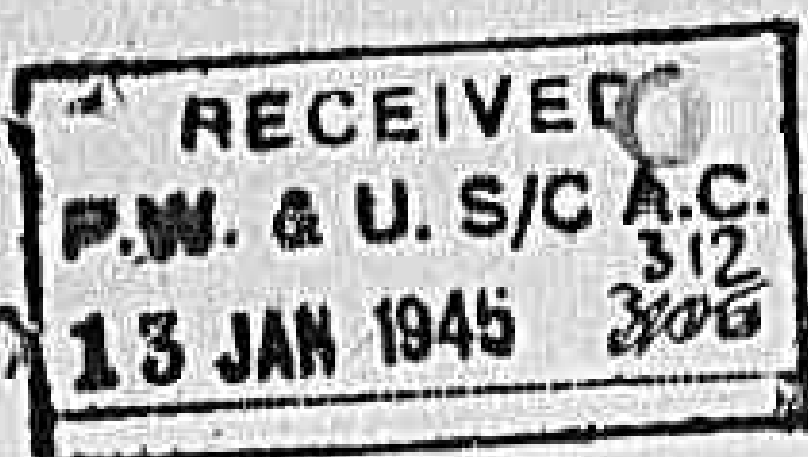

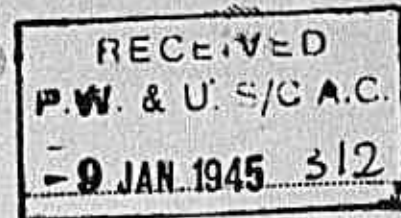
