SADE Co. inform us of the following :

at Venice, besides Azienda Cellina that supply electrical energy in town and province, there is also the General Staff of all the Adriatica Group and so all the technical services relative to the production and transmission of the energy in the all Venezia Region, and also in a part of the Emilia as far as Rimini. At Venice there are also the seats of the General Staffs and Central Managers and Chiefs of Service; that is beside 20 engineers who have jurisdiction on all the Group and therefore they have always the necessity to move themselves in all the Region and also as far as Milan and Rome for the connection with the other electrical Groups, with the Authorities of the Govern and Allied and with the suppliers of the materials; this necessity now-a-days is more ~~noticeable~~ remarkable for the works of reconstructions. As for the lacking of the other means of transportations, such displacements can be made only with cars.

Actually the Adriatica Group has only 11 cars with the authorization for the circulation released by A.M.G. cap. Lee, of Venice, of which only two are destined to the Azienda of Distribution of the Province and the other three are dislocated by the plants for the emergency, so that only 6 cars are at General technical Staff's disposal. Such a number is not sufficient, also as these cars are wasted in all the mechanisms and are ~~far~~ nearly always in restoration. So it is absolutely necessary, in the interest of the electrical service of all the Venezia Regions, that the ~~an~~ allotment of the cars must be increased of at least three cars and therefore also the authorization of circulation. We ~~wx~~ wish to note you that the next new authorization must be given to the car 7819 UD.

1. We have received a directive from the Economic Section Headquarters Allied Commission, giving instructions as to the method to be used to increase utility rates.
2. We have just learned from the Power Company S.I.P. of this Region that P.W.&U. Sub-Commission of Rome has authorized an increase in electric rates effective Sept. 1st 1945, and an announcement has been published in the Italian newspaper of this area.
3. We have not been notified of any increases in the rates, and Col. Bolick, Regional Engineer at Milano, tells me that he has not been notified.
4. As we are getting ready to turn things over to the Italians, and understand that you are to remain in Northern Italy, I am writing to suggest that you clarify this conflict and instructions so the people will know what to expect, and have all areas notified.
5. If there is anything we can do from here to be of any assistance please let me know.

OFFICIAL BULLETIN OF THE PRICES COMMITTEE NORTH ITALY.

N. 1. Sept. 16th 1945

EXTRACTDELIBERATION No. 3 : ENERGY PRICES

The North Italy Prices Committee, in virtue of the power conferred by agreement between the Italian Government and the Allied Commission according with MEMORANDUM'S Memorandum, ref/100/Es, July 9th 1945, heard the opinion of the Industrial Council North Italy :

DELIBERATES ;

Art. 1. Starting the 1st Sept. the societies that supply electrical energy are authorized to apply the following increases on the prices and rates legally operating at the date of the entering in force of this deliberation :

- a). 150% for the supplies of the lighting use in private houses and other electrodomestic uses.
- b). 200% for all the uses different from that in paragraph indicated.

For the users, lodgers of worker and popular houses, with total installed power not higher than 100 W. the increase of the paragraph a) is reduced to the 100%.

Art. 2. The disposals of the Art. 1 paragraph b) will not be applicated to the electrical energy supply under permissions, conventions and contracts, in which the supply of electrical energy has been agreed in relation to the regulations of different reports, on condition that these permissions, conventions and contracts ~~XXXXX~~ have not availed, because not yet arrived to the original expiration, of the legislative delay established in the penultimate paragraph of the art. 1 of the n.d.l. 12 March 1941, n.142 and successive disposals.

To these contracts will be applied starting from the 1st of Sept. 1945 one increase to be fixed in agreement on both sides.

If the parts don't agree, the rate will be fixed by an arbitral College which will deliberate as friendly composer and in inappealable manner according (1) the disposals of this deliberation, (2) the conditions on which the contract was stipulated, (3) the cost increases attended.

The arbitral College will be composed by three members, two named by each part and the third chosen among three names proposed by the President of the Trade Chamber authorized in the territory where the delivery of the energy is performed. Each part must name its own arbitrator inside the term of 30 days beginning from the notify day.

Art. 3. The disposals of the Art. 1. paragraph b) will be not applicated to the electrical energy supply under contracts that have a clause of price revision that is inefficient by the art. 15 and 16 June 1938 n.1387 disposal and successive ones, on condition that these permissions, conventions and contracts have not availed, because not yet arrived at the original expiration, of the legislative delay established in the penultimate paragraph of the art. 1 of the n.d.l. 12 March 1941, n.142 and

successive disposals.
for these contracts the increase will be established, always starting from the 1st of Sept. 1945, on the bases of the clauses of revisions contained in the same contracts. If the clause should not be applicable or by one of the parts should retained inadequate to the present situation, the establishment of the increase will be deferred to an arbitral Counsel of three Members to be nominated as art. 22

art. 3 -The increase of the art. 1 will be applicated also to all the permission conventions or contracts operating at the date of the 1st Sept. 1945. The users who don't intend accept the price variations have the faculty to give up the contract without charge.

It is pointed out that the load in Bologna is rising daily and is now about 18,000 KW, while the 120/50/15 KV transformer is only 15,000 KVA (10,000 KVA on the 15 KV winding.)

- 1) - This morning has come here Dr. ORLANDO and Dr. MONTA', respectively General Manager and Technical Director of Soc. Metallurgica Italiana " Fornaci di Barga " (Lucca Prov.).
- 2) - They informed us that their plants are :
 - a) - Wire drawing (Barga)
 - b) - Rolling Plant (Campo Tizoro)
 - c) - Foundry and Pipe Factory (Leghorn). This plant now is not free because transformed in Car Repairing Shop by the 8° Army.
- 3) - They have repaired the damages in the Plants a) and b) and now the Barga plant can draw about 70-80 Ton of copper-wire a day.
- 4) - The Barga plant is composed of the following Sections :
 - a) - Electrical Foundry. For heavy alloys (Copper alloys) and light alloys (Aluminium Alloys) from scrap. (No kind of fuel required because Electrical Furnaces. Valdarno can supply ~~2000~~ 2000 kW and in few days 5,000 kW.
 - b) - Electrolytic plant. For 1,000 Tons a month. (Actually unable to work because German took away the lead-sheets. All plant in order but needs 370-400 Tons of lead. They say that for the requested conductivity by Electrical Societies and the quality of the scraps it is not necessary the electrolysis of copper.
 - c) - Drawing plant. From founded bars. For 70-80 Tons a day.
 - d) - Meandering Plant. For prepare wires for cables. In full efficiency.
- 5) - Actually the plant cannot work for lack of raw materials.

- 6) -The above mentioned Society,(connected with Tempini Soc.Brescia), to save materials from German robberies,sent his raw materials to Brescia. In Tempini plant existing now about 1500 Tons,(of which about 500 of Copper) of scraps awnership of Metallurgica Soc.
- 7) -This Society has already received orders for about 1000 Tons of wire and cable from Central Italy Societies,but not yet arrived in Barga any scraps.
- 8) - They ask your authorization to transport this 500 Tons of Copper from Brescia to Barga to start soon the work,while they are waiting for the scrap arrival from Center Italy.The transport will be made with 5 trucks,awnership of the Society,authorized from A.M.G. HQ. Florence,and functioning with charcol-gasogene.(No petrol or any fuel required).
- 9) -I have spoken about with Capt.Elliot,and he has nothing to object. It is only necessary your approval for this transport.
- 10) -Peraphs Dr.Orlando might meet you in Rome next Monday and you are already acquainted with this matter.

1) - The situation on wire drawing has resolved down to employing a company by the name of "TRAFILERIE E LAMINATOI DI METALLI" located at VILLA CARCINA (about 15 Km. north of Brescia). So far this is the only plant that we have seen that really is in a position to do the work and ready to start immediately. Their price and terms seem to be in line. They are short of fuel but that is natural rather than exceptional. They are starting on some work now and will get some fuel soon.

2) - Engineer Salce is completing the arrangements for the wire drawing for S.A.D.E. and the wire drawing Company has been instructed to start this job as soon as possible.

3) - Capt. Best is returning to Bologna to-day and can give you additional information on this subject. Have asked Capt. Best to return to Milan on temporary duty orders Monday or Tuesday as I have to be away for approx one week - TURIN - GENOA and ROME. The work here required that someone be here almost daily, and in accordance with an agreement with Col. Lapper in Florence last Friday Capt. Best will be reassigned to this office.

I - ELECTRIC POWER REHABILITATION

AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 58, 1944, and Section I, Administrative Memorandum Number 7, 1945, are rescinded.

- ✓ 1) - The Electrical Reconstruction Committee created by above Administrative Memorandum is dissolved.
- ✓ 2) - The functions of electric power rehabilitation are transferred to the Allied Commission.
- ✓ 3) - Military agencies engaged in electric power rehabilitation activities will coordinate their plans with the Allied Commission.

II - LOCAL RESOURCES IN ITALY - MAINLAND & ISLANDS

AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 52, 1944, is amended as follows :

- 1) - Section I, Paragraph 2, Restricted Items is amended by the addition of the following after Item I :
"7. Poplar Wood"
