- 1.- As we informed you during your inspection at our plant of Villa Carcina (Brescia), among other problems, particular attention was to be drawn to the lack of transportation, precluding at present the possibility of a normal supply of our plant in Villa Carcina, from Milano.
- 2.- Following what suggested by Lt.Cl.Parker, our Co. sent several applications to the R.A.C.I., Ufficio Trasporti del Commissario del Ministero della Produzione Industriale, and to the Ufficio Autotrasporti Milano, but all to no purpose, for we have never been succeed in getting a truck, so that we have been obliged to apply to the usual transport Companies, which charge us Lit. 2,50/3 per Kg., without assuring us a regular work.
- 3.- In these conditions and considering that the activity of our plants is, at present, interesting the Railway and Electrical Companies, we decided to buy a lorry from the O.M. - Brescia.
- 4.- In accordance with the acting dispositions issued by the A.M.G. the seller - O.M. Brescia - will submit the contract for the approval of the interested Office and may we ask your kind assistance on the matter, in order to obtain the authorization to buy the a/m lorry.
