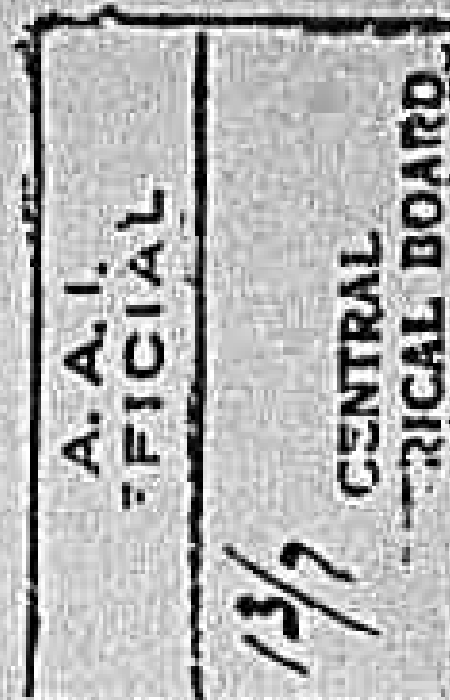

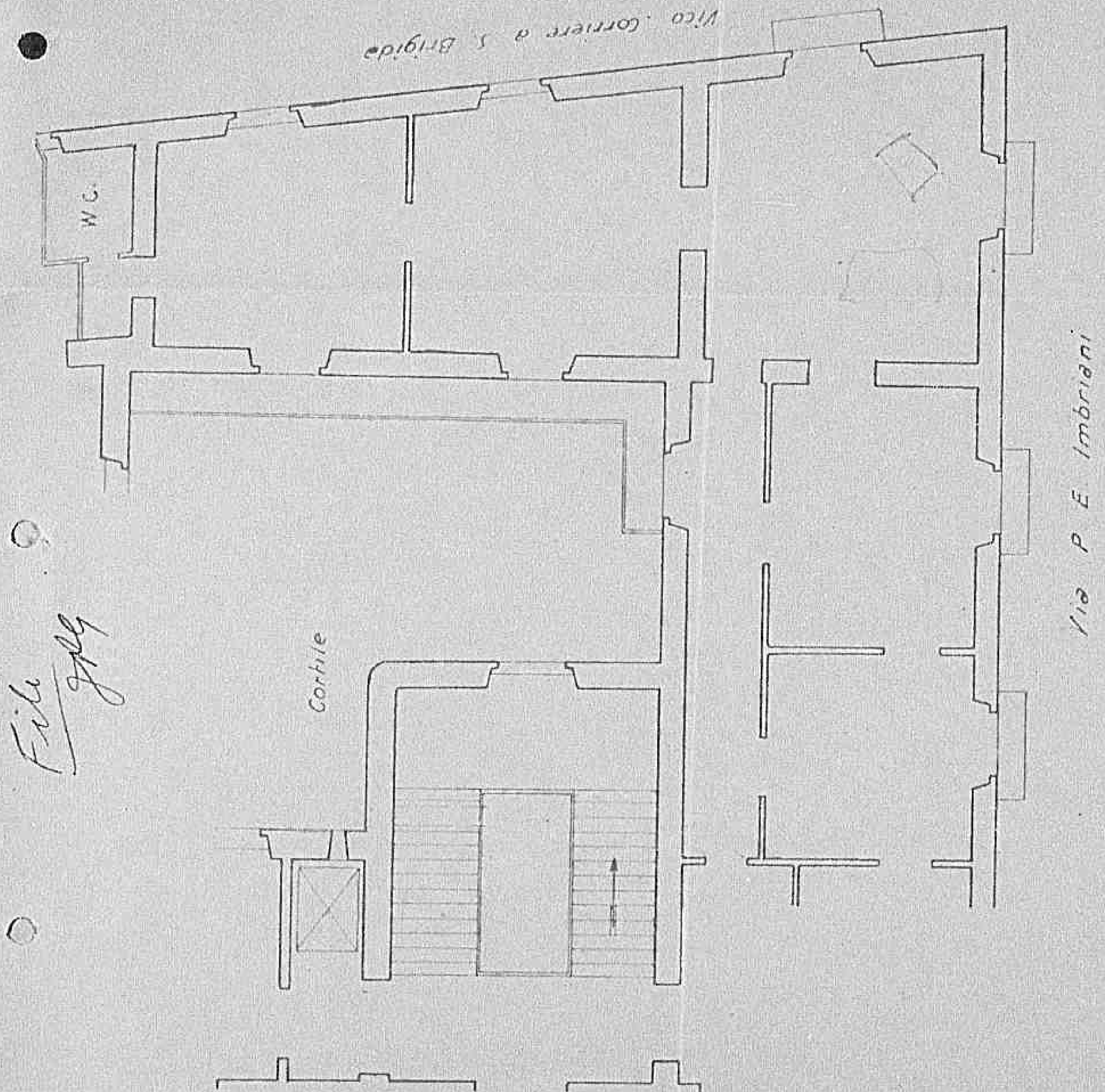

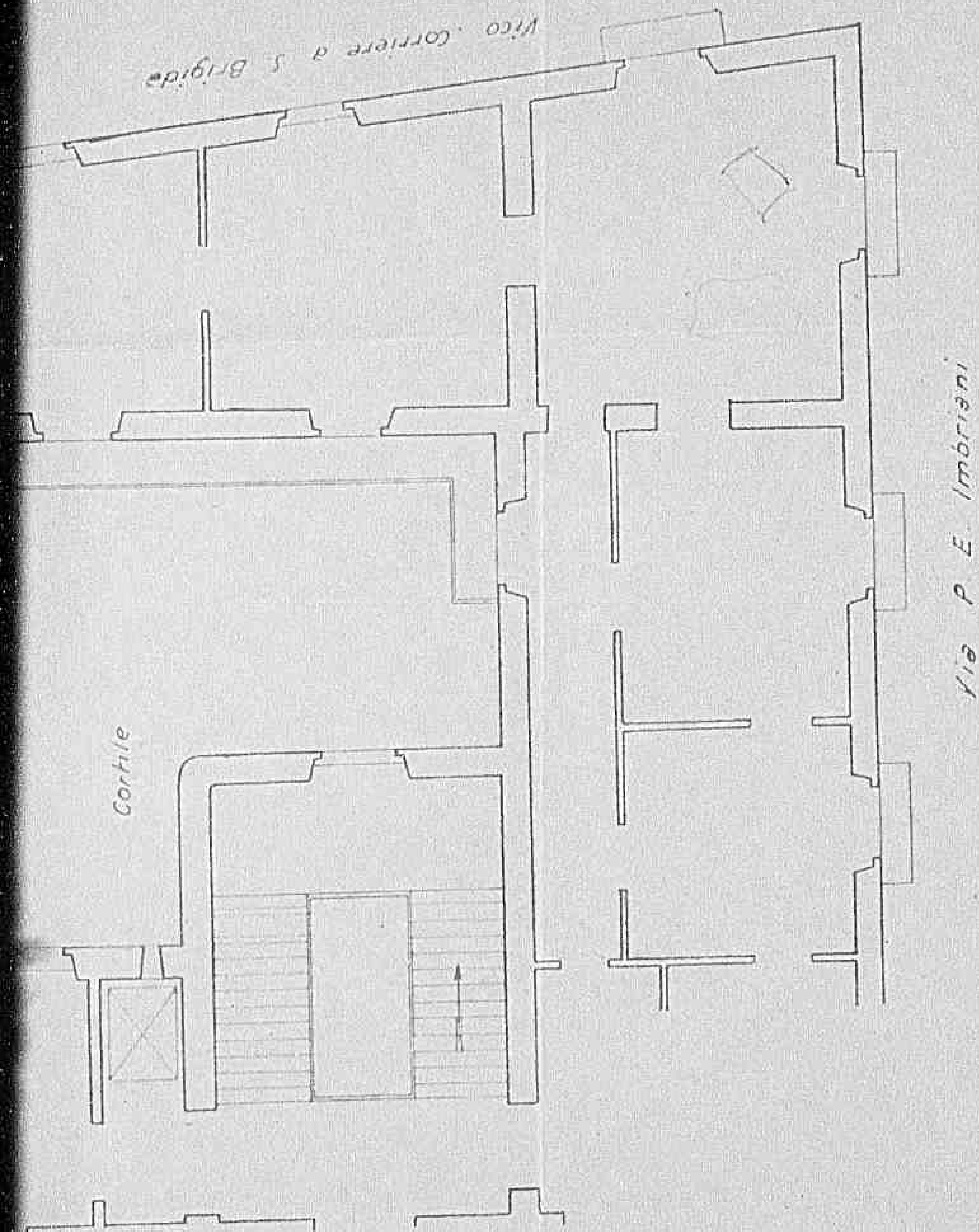
3. The rooms referred to above would provide adequate and convenient offices for the A.C.M.F. Central Electrical Board and if allotted to the Board would facilitate its operation.
