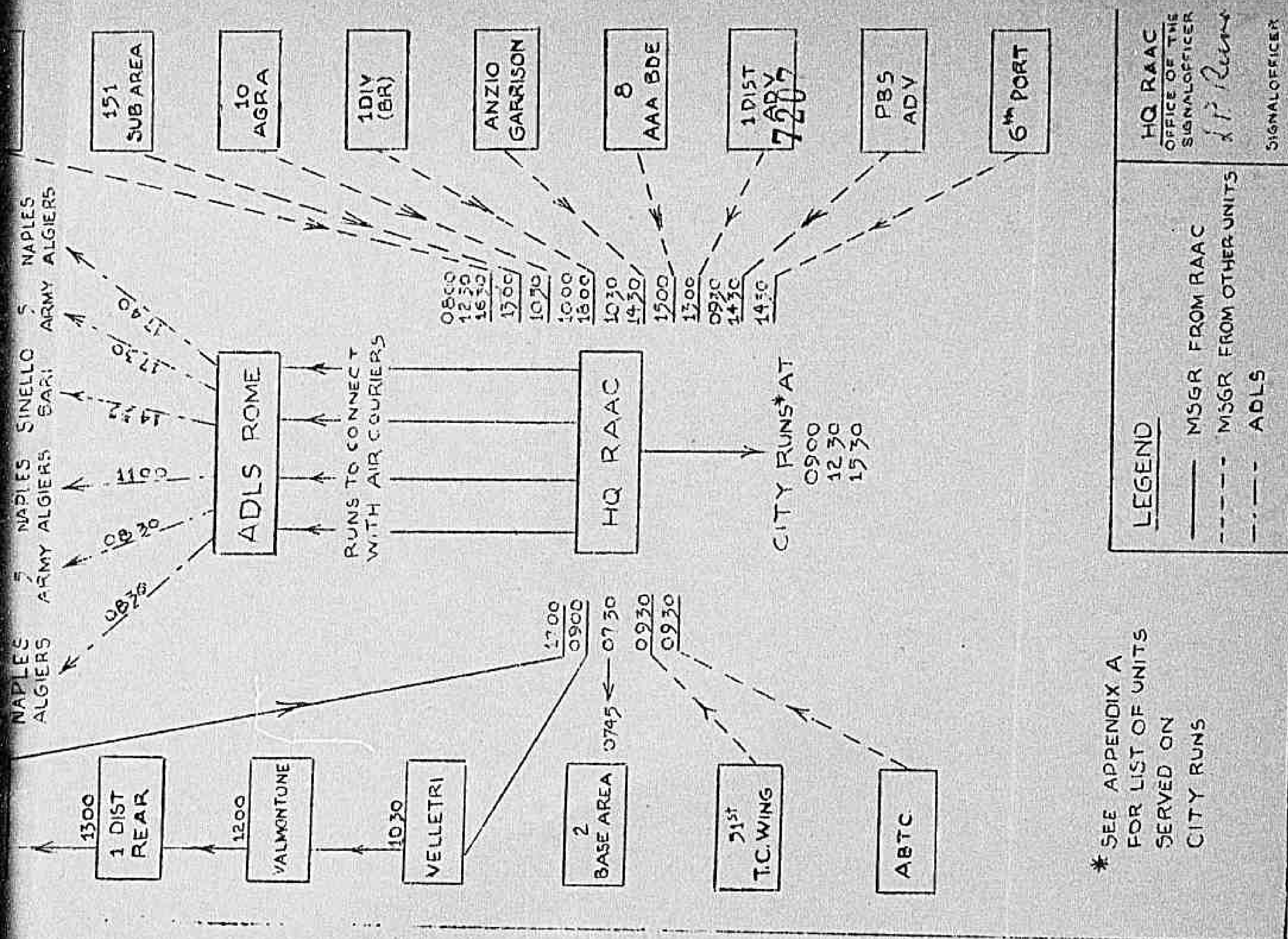

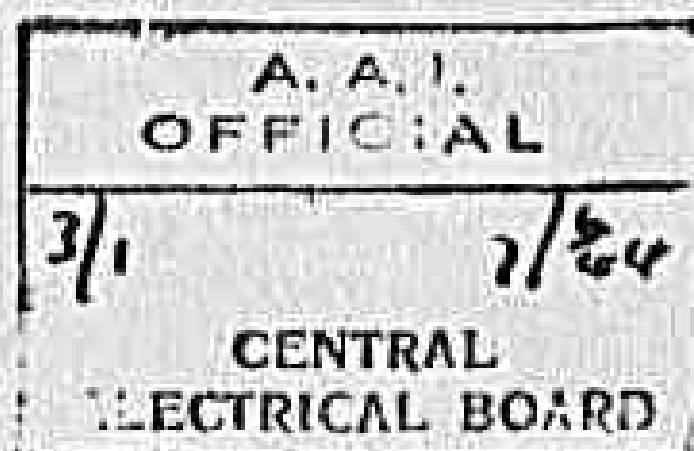

1. In compliance with paragraph 2, Signal Circular 21, Headquarters Fifth Army, Office of the Signal Officer, dated 13 April 1944, the following report of anticipated use of a power transmission line for telephone service is submitted.

a. The line desired consists of two 3-phase circuits on steel towers, insulated for voltages of the order of 50,000, between vicinity Piedmonte Ravoli (M921883) and vicinity Garigliano River (M830933).

b. Use of the line is expected to begin on 3 May 1944 and continue until rear elements of the corps are able to cross the Garigliano.

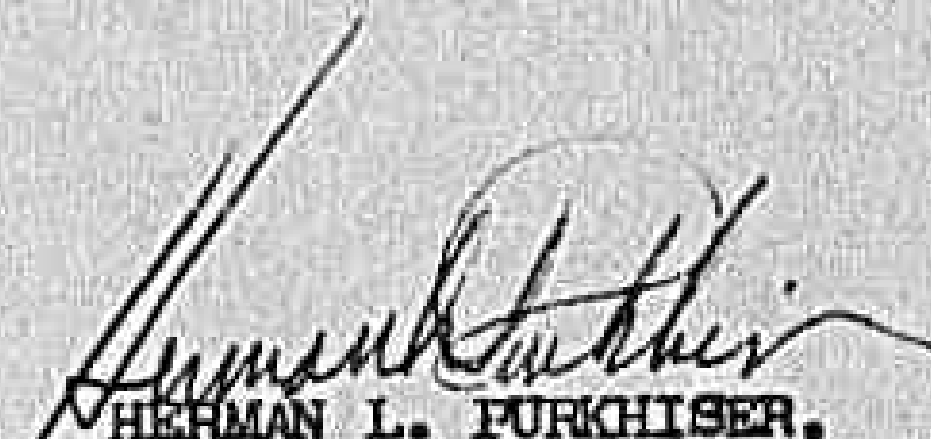

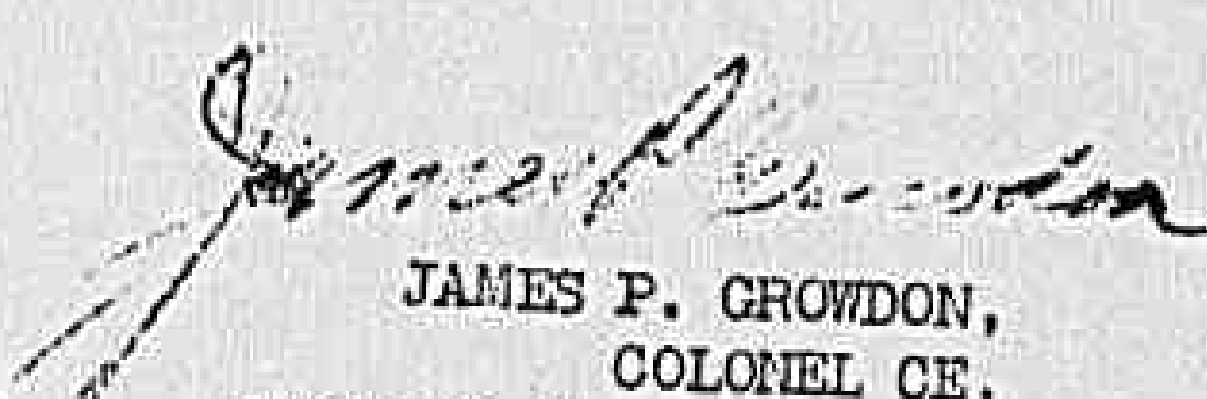
