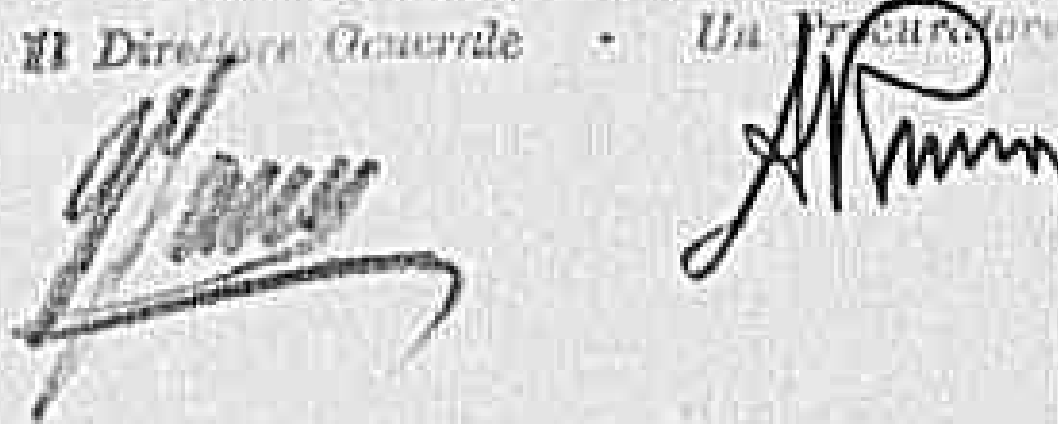

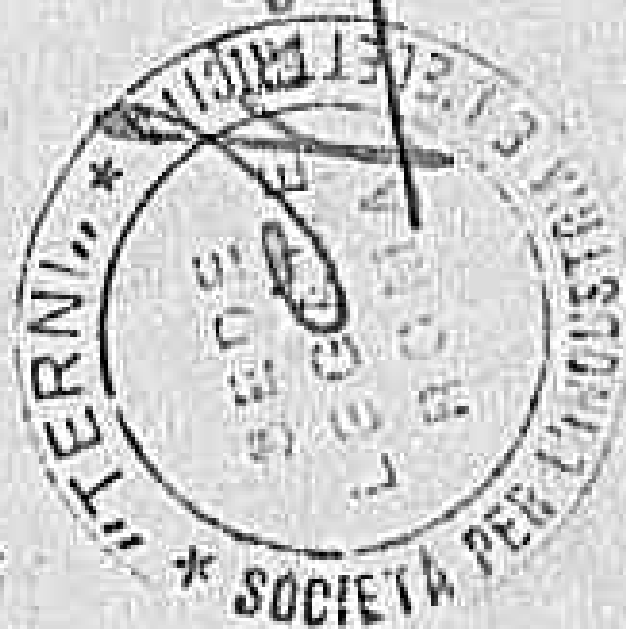

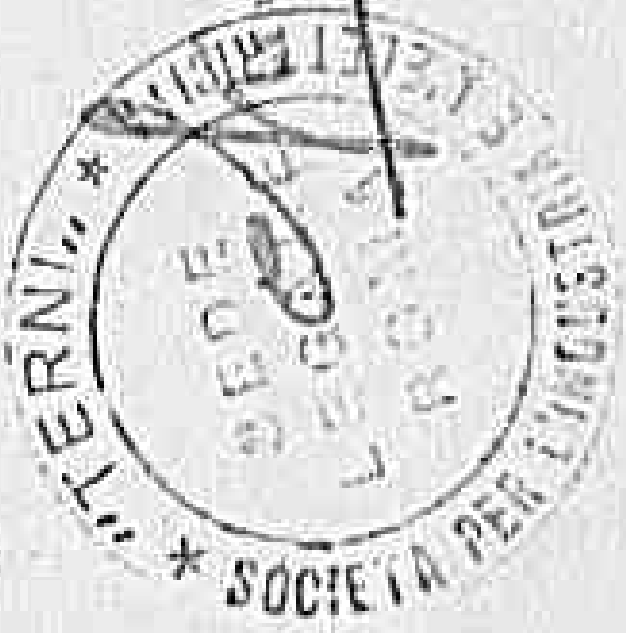

SUBJECT:- Passes

TO:- CE HQ AAI.

1. The following comments on the draft Routine Order are submitted in compliance with your instructions for comments from the AAI Central Electrical Board. The comments submitted are applicable only to passes for officials, engineers and workmen of Power Coys.

- (a) In practically no case do the power systems conform to Army, District or ACC Region boundaries, and it is necessary for officials, engineers and workmen from one area to pass freely to other areas where work must be done. Without such free passage the work of repair and rehabilitation of the power systems becomes impossible.
- (b) It is therefore desirable that one pass - which would be honoured in all areas - be issued to each of the Power Coy people whose duties require them to move from one area to another. This pass should properly identify the person and be non-transferable; it should state specifically the nature of the work on which the bearer is engaged and be valid only when so engaged; it should be issued for a period of not less than six months and should be withdrawn immediately the person to whom it is issued is no longer engaged on Power Coy work. A careful record should be kept of all passes issued and the Power Coys should be instructed to immediately notify the issuing authority whenever any employee ceases to be so employed.
- (c) AMG/ACC originally issued limited passes to Power Coy workmen in the NAPLES area but these passes were totally ineffective to permit satisfactory repair and operation of the power system of Southern Italy, and special permits were required at frequent intervals. Securing these special permits always involved difficulties and delays and uselessly wasted time of the issuing authority. During one period no passes were available for a period of approx one month and work on essential transmission lines was stopped for this reason. The AAI Central Electrical Board endeavoured to secure passes issued by AMG/ACC, and failing to do so, was authorised by AAI to issue passes which were honoured in all areas. No abuse of these passes has ever been reported.
- (d) The AAI Central Electrical Board issued passes to Power Coy officials, engineers and workmen only because no other agency was either willing or in a position to do so. The AAI C.E.B. is not staffed adequately to issue, record and check the thousands of passes which will be required to permit the effective rehabilitation of the electric power system in ITALY, although it was able to function for a single Power Coy operating in the Southern Section.

(c) It is recommended that all passes for officials, engineers and workmen of Electric Power Coys be issued by one agency of AAI. These passes should be specifically for Power Coy people and should properly identify and authorise bearer operating or riding in military or civilian vehicles and should be on durable stiff paper.
