Most all supplies are now handled by the Italian Government, but in many cases, demands from civilian firms ^{require} to have an endorsement to the effect that, material so demanded is essential to the programs of reconstruction, and that the release of the material has the approval of Allied Commission.

A number of tyres were made available to Public Utilities Companies from Military sources, during July, this has considerably eased the transportation problem.

As we pointed out with our letter of the 18th inst., we have the possibility of rapidly supplying your Administration with Pyrex glass suspended insulators for the main high tension line of the Ferrovie dello Stato if we can obtain the necessary assignment of fuel for the oven.

With our letter of the 18th inst. we proposed a supply of 6000 suspended insulators for which we indicated the conditions: we now add that we could supply in a few months 6000 more suspended Pyrex insulators for high tension main lines (for which we reserve to detail the conditions) if we will be put in position/ to rapidly reactivate our installations.

Considering that our Pyrex glass oven once it has to continue uninterrupted, day and night, its productive activity until spent; considering that to compensate the construction expenses and starting of the oven, it would be advisable to foresee a continual working cycle of at least 4 months; considering that the necessary quantity of fuel per month, for the ovens activity, is of 210 tons of naphtha (semi dense oil, type 5.) and considering that the initial heating phase is not productive, of 15 days duration, we kindly request you to interest the competent authorities in order to obtain for our Acqui factory a total assignment of 945 tons of naphtha distributed over a period of 4 months.

For our part, we can undertake to deliver, besides the 12.000 insulators in question, also 40.000 telephone insulators and many thousands of levelling tubes, also necessary to your Administration for the railway service.

Will you please bear in mind, as also the Ministries concerned, that in the same working period, with the same consumption of naphtha, and, therefore, with a noticeable benefit to the national economy, we can produce other articles of great utility such as:-

- globes for night fishing with lamps,
- household utensils which the domestic economy lacks because of the difficulty to obtain supplies of metals,

- articles for textile and chemical, etc.
factories required in glass or inoxidisable
and resistant to heat, that Pyrex glass can
very well replace.

Attached hereto are two translated copies of letters received from M.I.C.I. in reply to requests, submitted in accordance with instructions contained in AG/5300/Commerce dated 28 March 45, since which date this Division has only received a total of 42,663 Kgs. of all the requests submitted through these channels.
2. In addition to the letters attached we have also received four similar letters stating that requests for steelwork cannot be met.
3. Under these circumstances it would appear useless to submit any further requests to M.I.C. meanwhile the programme of electrical rehabilitation, so far as it effects the reconstruction of war damaged hydro-electric plants, is being seriously retarded.



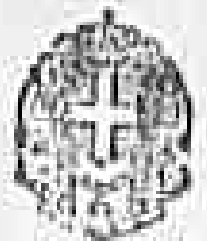

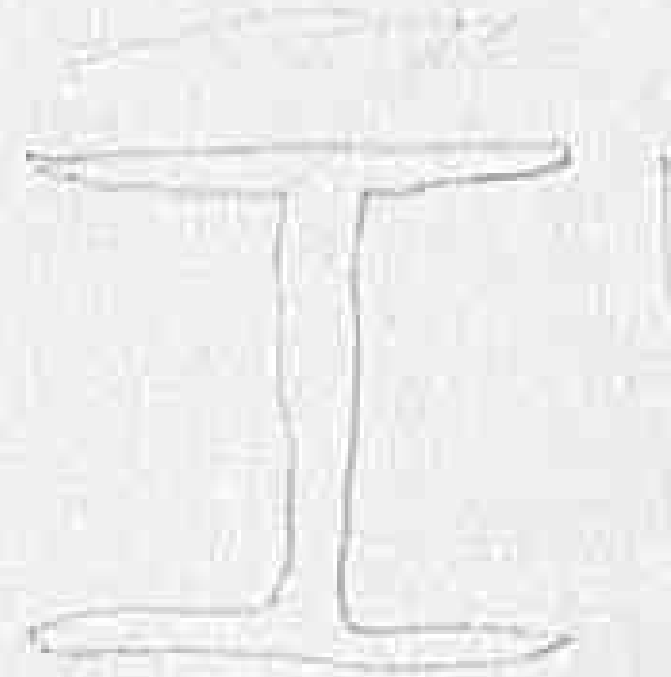

Therefore, a Duty Officer for each section is to be designated to handle emergency situations or to contact the parties concerned.



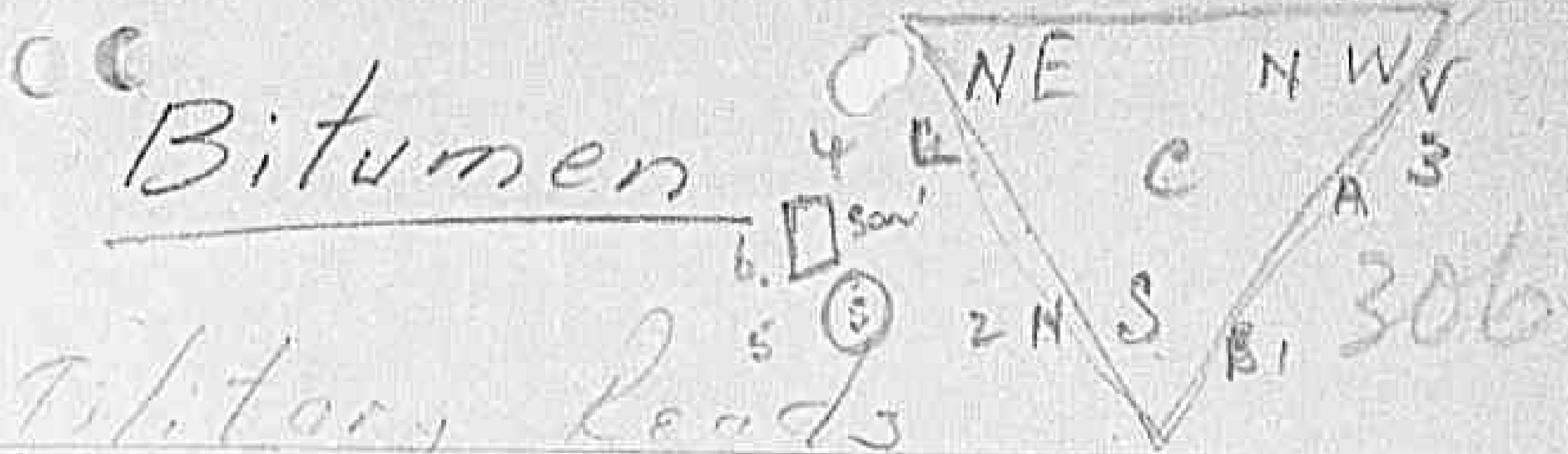
